Synopsis of Senate Memorial 6

Senate Memorial 6 requests Legislative Council to install a plaque in the state capital to recognize the significance of the 100th anniversary of the passage of the 19th amendment to the United States Constitution giving women the right to vote.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The exact cost to purchase and install a plaque in unknown but expected to be minimal and not exceed \$100 thousand. Without an appropriation Legislative Council Services or Legislative Building Services will need to absorb the cost.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The state organization of Daughters of the American Revolution is a nonprofit, nonpolitical, volunteer women's service organization founded in 1890 with 16 chapters in New Mexico. Membership is diverse with a goal of education, patriotism, history, and historic preservation including recognition of significant events in national and state history.
