10 AN ACT

11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE PUBLIC EDUCATION DEPARTMENT TO
12 SUSTAIN AND EXPAND COMPREHENSIVE AND AFFORDABLE STATEWIDE OUT-
13 OF-SCHOOL TIME PROGRAMMING FOR SCHOOL-AGE YOUTH STATEWIDE.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.**--Twenty million dollars
17 (\$20,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
18 public education department for expenditure in fiscal year 2027
19 and subsequent fiscal years to sustain and expand comprehensive
20 and affordable statewide out-of-school time programming for
21 school-age youth statewide. From the amount appropriated, ten
22 million dollars (\$10,000,000) shall be for school districts,
23 charter schools, the United States department of the interior's
24 bureau of Indian education schools and tribally controlled
25 schools, and ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) shall be for

1 contracting with local and statewide nonprofit community
2 organizations that provide out-of-school time programming. Any
3 unexpended balance remaining at the end of a fiscal year shall
4 not revert to the general fund.
