### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Choose an item.

Senate Bill 168 (SB168) appropriates \$150 thousand from the general fund to the local government division at the Department of Finance and Administration for the purpose of the Estancia Valley Solid Waste Authority to plan and design a recycling site for wind turbine blades.

The effective date of this bill is July 1, 2026.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$150 thousand contained in this bill is a nonrecurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY27 shall revert to the general fund.

### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Wind turbines are difficult to recycle and take up significant space in landfills in Wyoming, Iowa, South Dakota, and Texas. Recycling wind turbines could potentially serve as a new industry in New Mexico.

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
