### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Senate Bill 210

Senate Bill 210 appropriates \$80 million from the general fund to New Mexico Highlands University (NMHU) for the purpose of constructing a soccer field for the women's soccer team and for improvements to the football field, track, natatorium, and golf course.

This bill does not contain an effective date and, as a result, would go into effect 90 days after the Legislature adjourns, which is May 20, 2026.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$80 million contained in this bill is a nonrecurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY27 shall revert to the general fund.

### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

NMHU reports having an athlete headcount of 421 and states that the renovation will also allow NMHU to add sports, starting with men's track and field.
