Synopsis of Senate Joint Memorial 1

Senate Joint Memorial 1 (SJM1) would urge the U.S. Congress to pass legislation to require uniform redistricting criteria and uniform process standards for the U.S. House of Representatives apportionment and to prohibit states from midcycle redistricting unless ordered by a court.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS
