10 A JOINT MEMORIAL

11 REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, IN COORDINATION
12 WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, TO ESTABLISH A STATEWIDE
13 PROGRAM TO DESIGNATE HIGHWAY SEGMENTS AS MEMORIAL CORRIDORS IN
14 HONOR OF NEW MEXICO STATE POLICE OFFICERS WHO WERE KILLED IN
15 THE LINE OF DUTY AND DIRECTING THE FIRST DESIGNATION TO HONOR
16 OFFICER DARIAN JARROTT ON INTERSTATE 10 IN LUNA COUNTY.

18 WHEREAS, since 1935, the New Mexico state police has been
19 entrusted with protecting the lives, property and safety of all
20 New Mexicans; and

21 WHEREAS, many brave officers have made the ultimate
22 sacrifice in the line of duty, giving their lives in service to
23 others; and

24 WHEREAS, the legislature of the state of New Mexico
25 recognizes that these fallen officers deserve permanent and

1 visible recognition for their selfless commitment to justice
2 and public safety; and

3 WHEREAS, designating highway segments as memorial
4 corridors where officers served or lost their lives will
5 preserve their memory and remind all who travel these roads of
6 the cost of public safety;

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
8 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the department of transportation and
9 the department of public safety be requested to establish a
10 statewide program to designate highway segments as memorial
11 corridors in honor of New Mexico state police officers who were
12 killed in the line of duty and direct the first designation to
13 honor officer Darian Jarrott on interstate 10 in Luna county;
14 and

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each segment bear the
16 officer's name and rank and be marked by a sign stating: "In
17 honor of [rank] [full name], New Mexico State Police - Killed
18 in the Line of Duty"; and

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the department of
20 transportation be requested to use available funds, including
21 private donations, to fund the fabrication, installation and
22 maintenance of the memorial signs and coordinate with local
23 governments, civic organizations and law enforcement
24 associations for ceremonies and dedications; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the department of public

1 safety be requested to maintain an official registry made
2 available on the department's website of the fallen state
3 police officers, listing each officer's name and date of death
4 and the corresponding memorial highway segment; and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
6 transmitted to the secretary of transportation, the secretary
7 of public safety, the chief of the New Mexico state police and
8 the families of fallen state police officers.
