21	A. The "big game depredation damage fund" is
22	created in the state treasury. The fund consists of
23	appropriations made to the fund, revenues received by the

the fund. The fund shall be administered by the department and money in the fund is appropriated to the department to carry out the provisions of Subsection B of this section. Payments from the fund shall be by warrant of the secretary of finance and administration upon vouchers signed by the director of the department or [his] the director's authorized representative. Balances in the fund shall not revert to any other fund.

The department of game and fish shall, by rule, 8 Β. 9 establish a program to correct damage to federal, state or private land caused by big game, [and] to prevent such damage 10 in the future and to compensate landowners for the financial 11 12 damages caused by big game. Pursuant to rules adopted by the department, expenditures from the big game depredation damage 13 fund shall be made by the department to carry out the 14 established program; provided that money in the fund shall not 15 be expended for any administrative costs." 16
