SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 527 appropriates \$250.0 from the general fund to the New Mexico Office of Indian Affairs for the purpose of contracting to provide telecommunications assessment, planning and technical assistance for the Eight Northern Indian Pueblos and surrounding communities.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS
