# **SUMMARY**

## Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 613 appropriates \$200.0 from the general fund to DOH for the purpose of providing temporary lodging in a residential facility in Albuquerque specifically for adult and child cancer patients and their families visiting Albuquerque for treatment purposes.

# Significant Issues

The General Appropriation Act of 2000 included \$50.0 for this facility (Casa Esperanza). Currently, HB2 contains no funding for the facility.

## FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$200.0 contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY02 shall revert to the general fund.

#### TECHNICAL ISSUES

HPC indicates the bill includes no criteria (i.e., specified income level) as to who may use the facility.
