House Joint Memorial 38 (HJM 38) proclaims February 13, 2013 as "Community Schools Day" at the Legislature.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Community schools focus on increasing learning time for students, engaging families, coordinating resources and strengthening community and school connections. Community schools also include comprehensive behavioral and primary health services to remove non-academic barriers to learning.

Community schools are catalysts for change, and HJM 38 asks school districts to consider the community school strategy as an allowable intervention and remediation strategy for low-performing schools.
