House Memorial 69 recognizes New Mexican women veterans and the Women Veterans of New Mexico organization and declares February 21st, 3013 "Women Veterans of New Mexico Day" in the House of Representatives.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

HM 69 notes that New Mexico is home to more than 16 thousand female veterans, and the Women Veterans of New Mexico organization works to with women veterans after they are discharged from active duty through outreach and mentoring, and work to provide for the needs of women who suffer from PTSD, military sexual trauma and other mental and physical injuries.

This memorial passed unanimously in the House of Representatives on February 21, 2013.
