#### Synopsis of Bill

House Memorial 8 honors the heroism of a teacher and commends the employees of the Roswell Independent School District.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

On January 14, 2014, over five hundred children were endangered by gunfire at Berrendo High School in Roswell, NM, and two children were seriously injured. John Masterson, a teacher, stepped in front of the shooter and talked him into giving up his gun. Other teachers and staff reacted with decisiveness to attend to injured children and protect others. The Roswell Independent School District and community should be commended for having provided “active shooter” training to its employees prior to this tragedy and for their exemplary response and spirit.
