#### Synopsis of Bill

House Memorial 37 requests that the Higher Education Department examine state programs, policies, procedures, and accompanying budget and funding processes including the Legislative Lottery Scholarship Program, to identify where tribal colleges are excluded. A report is requested to be available by 90 days before the 2015 legislative session.

# FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There may be slight administrative costs to the HED to carry out the request of the memorial; however, costs should be minor.

#### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The memorial requests the final report address how tribal colleges can be included in state programs, policies, procedures and regulations, and identify the manner in which the legislature and state agencies can use statute and rule to implement the report's recommendation.

This memorial was passed and signed in the 2013 legislative session; no report was carried out.
