# Synopsis of HGEIC

The Hosue Government, Elections & Indian Affairs Committee amendment for House Bill 136 updates program named for the Workforce Solutions Department by striking reference to the "unemployment insurance" program and inserting "employment services" program.

### Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 136 proposes to rename two divisions at the New Mexico Department of Workforce Solutions. The Workforce Transition Services Division will become the Unemployment Insurance Division, and the Business Services Divisions will become the Employment Services Division. This bill will align Workforce Solutions Department division names with the modern service functions.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS
