SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 31 appropriates \$250 thousand from the general fund to the board of regents at University of New Mexico (UNM) to support a civic leadership and legislative processes training program for Hispanic high school students through the division of student affairs.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$250 thousand in this bill is a nonrecurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY16 shall revert to the general fund.

According to HED, this request was not submitted by the UNM board of regents to HED as part of the research and public service project review--a formal process for reviewing earmarked budget requests for higher education institutions.
