#### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Memorial 84 calls upon an interim criminal justice committee to hear testimony on the benefits of passing a New Mexico Law Enforcement Officers Safety Act modeled after the federal Law Enforcement Officer Safety Act of 2004 which allows qualified active duty law enforcement officers and retired or separate officers to carry a concealed firearm regardless of state or local restrictions on where concealed weapons can be carried.
