20	WHEREAS, Jaylyn was inspired to set aside a day for	
21	Native American solidarity when she looked at her own feet	
22	and realized that her footwear connected her to countless	
23	Native American and indigenous people; and	
24	WHEREAS, rock your mocs is an opportunity for people all

WHEREAS, participants post their photos on the internet through social media sites such as facebook, snapchat, instagram and pinterEst and by using the hashtag #rockyourmocs to create a record of the event; and

WHEREAS, while simultaneously creating awareness of national Native American heritage month, rock your mocs has also inspired people in other ways; and

WHEREAS, people have taken the initiative to organize moccasin-making workshops, Native American powwow round dances, community fun walks and runs in moccasins, and Native American and indigenous culture awareness events, connecting youth and elder events and other community celebrations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the governor be requested to declare November 15, 2017 "Rock Your Mocs Day" in New Mexico; and
