## A MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO ISSUE AN OPINION WHETHER PUBLIC MONEY MAY BE USED TO REHABILITATE OR MAINTAIN A PRIVATE ROAD FOR PUBLIC WELFARE PURPOSES.
