The board of regents of each state educational 11 institution designated in Article 12, Section 11 of the 12 constitution of New Mexico may employ and assign duties of 13 university police officers for the institution. 14 B. At all times while on duty, university police 15 officers shall carry commissions of office issued by the 16 board of regents. University police officers have the powers 17 of peace officers within the exterior boundaries of lands 18 under control of the board of regents employing them, 19 including public streets and highways within the boundaries, 20 or immediately adjacent to a campus where students are 21 educated. Within this territory, a university police officer 22 may enforce all applicable laws, ordinances and campus 23 traffic regulations, but no arrest for violation of any law, 24 ordinance or campus traffic regulation relating to motor 25
