AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PUBLIC PEACE, HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE;  
ADDING LOS LUCEROS TO THE LIST OF NEW MEXICO HISTORIC SITES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 18-3-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1975,  
Chapter 264, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"18-3-1. MUSEUM OF NEW MEXICO ESTABLISHED--LOCATION--  
PROPERTY.--

A. The "museum of New Mexico" is established. All  
properties, real or personal, now held for museum purposes  
and all properties, real or personal, that may be acquired  
for museum purposes at any time in the future shall be under  
the control of the museum board of regents of the museum of  
New Mexico.

B. The museum of New Mexico consists of:

- (1) the palace of the governors state  
history museum;
- (2) the New Mexico museum of art;
- (3) the museum of Indian arts and culture;
- (4) the museum of international folk art;
- (5) the archaeology division; and
- (6) the state historic sites:
  - (a) Coronado historic site;
  - (b) Jemez historic site;

- 1 (c) Fort Selden historic site;  
2 (d) Bosque Redondo memorial and Fort  
3 Sumner historic site;  
4 (e) Lincoln historic site;  
5 (f) El Camino Real historic trail site;  
6 (g) Fort Stanton historic site;  
7 (h) Taylor Reynolds Barela Mesilla  
8 historic site; and  
9 (i) Los Luceros historic site."

10 SECTION 2. Section 18-3-16 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2004,  
11 Chapter 25, Section 17, as amended) is amended to read:

12 "18-3-16. STATE HISTORIC SITES AND MONUMENTS DIVISION  
13 CREATED--BOARD OF REGENTS.--

14 A. The "state historic sites and monuments  
15 division" is created in the cultural affairs department. The  
16 division shall manage the state's historic sites and  
17 monuments, including:

- 18 (1) Coronado historic site;  
19 (2) Jemez historic site;  
20 (3) Fort Selden historic site;  
21 (4) Bosque Redondo memorial and Fort Sumner  
22 historic site;  
23 (5) Lincoln historic site;  
24 (6) El Camino Real historic trail site;  
25 (7) Fort Stanton historic site;

1 (8) Taylor Reynolds Barela Mesilla historic  
2 site; and

3 (9) Los Luceros historic site.

4 B. The state's historic sites shall operate under  
5 the imprimatur of the museum of New Mexico. The museum of  
6 New Mexico board of regents shall exercise trusteeship over  
7 state historic sites.

8 C. The director of the division shall meet the  
9 following minimum qualifications:

10 (1) hold a bachelor's or higher degree in a  
11 discipline related to the function of the division; and

12 (2) have significant experience in the  
13 management and operation of an organization similar to the  
14 division.

15 D. The director shall be appointed by the  
16 secretary of cultural affairs from a list of no less than  
17 three names provided by the museum of New Mexico board of  
18 regents."
