SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 475 requests the Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department (EMNRD) to draft legislation implementing a comprehensive carbon tax. SB475 appropriates \$475 thousand to the department to support the drafting.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$250 thousand contained in this bill is a nonrecurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY20 shall revert to the general fund.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

EMNRD reports that SB 475 supports Executive Order 2019-003 addressing climate change and requiring EMNRD to evaluate "adoption of a comprehensive market-based program that sets emission limits to reduce carbon dioxide, and other greenhouse gas pollution across New Mexico."
