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AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL OUTLAY; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TO
LOCAL STREETS AND ROADS, OTHER HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION
MATTERS AND FOR TRANSPORTATION-RELATED EQUIPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS.--Unless
otherwise provided in specific sections or subsections of
this act, the appropriations in this act are from the general
fund to the department of transportation for expenditure in
fiscal years 2020 through 2022. Unless otherwise provided,
any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining of any
appropriation in this act shall revert to the general fund
after completion of the project or at the end of fiscal year
2022, whichever occurs first.

SECTION 2. BERNALILLO COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS--
APPROPRIATIONS.--Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, the
following amounts are appropriated for the following purposes
in Bernalillo county:

A. three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to
plan, design, construct and install median and rights-of-way
landscaping along Alameda boulevard in Albuquerque;

B. five hundred ninety-five thousand dollars
(\$595,000) for road maintenance and lighting projects in the

1 South Valley in Albuquerque;

2 C. four hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$460,000)
3 to repair, restore and maintain Eubank, Academy and Juan Tabo
4 boulevards in Albuquerque;

5 D. one hundred forty-eight thousand seven hundred
6 fifty dollars (\$148,750) to construct, maintain and enhance
7 safety of bike paths throughout senate district 16 in
8 Albuquerque;

9 E. one hundred forty-eight thousand seven hundred
10 fifty dollars (\$148,750) to construct, maintain and enhance
11 crosswalks at public schools throughout senate district 16 in
12 Albuquerque;

13 F. one hundred forty-eight thousand seven hundred
14 fifty dollars (\$148,750) to study, design, develop,
15 construct, renovate, modernize, sign, enhance, landscape and
16 otherwise improve and acquire property and equipment for
17 streets, roads, medians, trails, bikeways, walkways,
18 sidewalks and railroad crossings in senate district 16 in
19 Albuquerque;

20 G. four hundred ninety-five thousand dollars
21 (\$495,000) for expenditure in fiscal years 2020 and 2021 to
22 restore, repair and maintain Tramway trailheads in
23 Albuquerque;

24 H. one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000)
25 for median landscaping, pedestrian trails and bicycle routes

1 on Broadway boulevard from Martin Luther King, Jr. avenue to
2 Lomas boulevard in Albuquerque;

3 I. one hundred forty-eight thousand seven hundred
4 fifty dollars (\$148,750) to plan, design and construct safety
5 enhancements for pedestrians and cyclists, including
6 sidewalks, bikeways, striping and other safety features, on
7 Lead and Coal avenues from Washington street to Yale
8 boulevard in Albuquerque;

9 J. one hundred thirty-five thousand dollars
10 (\$135,000) to plan, design, construct and install curb and
11 gutter, streets, sidewalks, walking paths, lighting and
12 landscaping in and around Los Altos park in Albuquerque;

13 K. one million three hundred forty-two thousand
14 five hundred dollars (\$1,342,500) to plan, design, acquire
15 rights of way, construct and otherwise improve Paseo del
16 Norte from Calle Nortena to Rainbow boulevard in Albuquerque;

17 L. five hundred ninety-five thousand dollars
18 (\$595,000) to complete safety redesign and construct the
19 intersection of Senator Dennis Chavez boulevard SW and
20 Condershine drive SW in Albuquerque;

21 M. one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000)
22 to plan, design, demolish, construct and install sidewalks
23 and lighting and make other street improvements in the Wells
24 Park neighborhood of Albuquerque;

25 N. one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000)

1 to purchase and install streetscape furnishings, including
2 bus shelters, bicycle racks, signage, trail markers and
3 median art, on Bridge boulevard from Barelas bridge to Coors
4 boulevard in Albuquerque;

5 O. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for
6 expenditure in fiscal years 2020 and 2021 to eliminate all
7 bus fares for youths up through high school in Albuquerque;

8 P. five hundred ninety-five thousand dollars
9 (\$595,000) to acquire rights of way and upgrade deficient
10 infrastructure, including replacing the storm drain at the
11 intersection of Barstow street and Alameda boulevard and
12 along Barstow street between Alameda boulevard and the La
13 Cueva channel; address federal Americans with Disabilities
14 Act of 1990 non-compliant sidewalks and multi-use trail;
15 remove and replace curb and gutter; make pavement and median
16 improvements; and improve intersection turn lanes, in
17 Albuquerque;

18 Q. five hundred ninety-five thousand dollars
19 (\$595,000) to plan, design, acquire rights of way, construct
20 and improve the interstate 40 and 118th street interchange in
21 Albuquerque;

22 R. one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000)
23 to install and upgrade street lighting in the international
24 district in Albuquerque city council district 6;

25 S. three hundred forty-five thousand dollars

1 (\$345,000) to plan, design, renovate, construct and improve
2 sidewalks and roadways to be compliant with the federal
3 Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 and to address
4 trails, bikeways, walkways, railroad crossings and bridges in
5 Albuquerque city council district 6;

6 T. two hundred forty-five thousand dollars
7 (\$245,000) to repair the access road for New Mexico
8 international school and create curb cuts from Chama street
9 to the parking lot in Albuquerque;

10 U. one hundred forty-five thousand dollars
11 (\$145,000) to install school crosswalks at various locations
12 in senate district 12 in Albuquerque;

13 V. two hundred ninety-five thousand dollars
14 (\$295,000) to plan, design and rehabilitate roads and streets
15 in senate district 13 in the North Valley in Albuquerque;

16 W. five hundred forty-seven thousand five hundred
17 dollars (\$547,500) to plan, design, acquire rights of way and
18 construct improvements to address settling and structural
19 issues with the University boulevard bridge over the Tijeras
20 arroyo in Albuquerque; and

21 X. three hundred forty-five thousand dollars
22 (\$345,000) to plan, design, construct and purchase rights of
23 way for renovation and repair of 4th street from Pueblo
24 Solano road to the village boundary north of Ortega road in
25 Los Ranchos de Albuquerque.

1 SECTION 3. CATRON COUNTY ROAD PROJECT--APPROPRIATION.--

2 Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, one hundred forty-five
3 thousand dollars (\$145,000) is appropriated for expenditure
4 in fiscal years 2020 and 2021 to purchase a road grader for
5 Catron county.

6 SECTION 4. CHAVES COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS--

7 APPROPRIATIONS.--Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, the
8 following amounts are appropriated for the following purposes
9 in Chaves county:

10 A. five hundred ninety-five thousand dollars
11 (\$595,000) to design, demolish and construct the bridge 6091
12 replacement project and a portion of north Garden avenue from
13 Cherry street north for one thousand five hundred feet in
14 Roswell; and

15 B. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for
16 expenditure in fiscal years 2020 and 2021 to purchase police
17 vehicles for the Roswell police department.

18 SECTION 5. CIBOLA COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS--

19 APPROPRIATIONS.--Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, the
20 following amounts are appropriated for the following purposes
21 in Cibola county:

22 A. two hundred forty-eight thousand one hundred
23 dollars (\$248,100) for expenditure in fiscal years 2020 and
24 2021 to purchase and equip a new road grader for the Ramah
25 Navajo department of transportation;

1 B. four hundred ninety-five thousand dollars
2 (\$495,000) to purchase road equipment and maintain various
3 roads in Cibola county; and

4 C. two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to
5 plan, design and construct subsurface drainage, including
6 replacing roadway inlets, storm drain pipes and roadway
7 repairs, on Washington avenue in Grants.

8 SECTION 6. COLFAX COUNTY ROAD PROJECT--APPROPRIATION.--

9 Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, one hundred fifteen
10 thousand dollars (\$115,000) is appropriated for expenditure
11 in fiscal years 2020 and 2021 to purchase a rock crusher,
12 bulldozer, excavator with hammer and a triple axle lowboy
13 trailer to transport equipment to road project locations in
14 Colfax county.

15 SECTION 7. CURRY COUNTY ROAD PROJECT--APPROPRIATION.--

16 Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, five hundred ninety-five
17 thousand dollars (\$595,000) is appropriated to plan, design
18 and construct improvements to county road P/Q, including
19 chipsealing nine miles from New Mexico highway 288 to county
20 road 34, in Curry county.

21 SECTION 8. DONA ANA COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS--

22 APPROPRIATIONS.--Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, the
23 following amounts are appropriated for the following purposes
24 in Dona Ana county:

25 A. four hundred eighty-five thousand dollars

1 (\$485,000) to plan, design and reconstruct Castillo road from
2 New Mexico highway 192 to New Mexico highway 28;

3 B. one hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000)
4 to plan, survey, design, repair and construct roadway and
5 drainage improvements on Grand avenue and Ford street in the
6 Salem colonia;

7 C. one hundred ten thousand dollars (\$110,000) to
8 plan, design and reconstruct San Felipe avenue from Tile
9 avenue to Tortugas cemetery in Las Cruces;

10 D. three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000)
11 to plan, design and construct Magistrate Court road roadway
12 and drainage improvements, including geotechnical
13 investigation, environmental planning and permitting,
14 topographic and right-of-way survey, federal Americans with
15 Disabilities Act of 1990 compliant wheelchair ramps,
16 sidewalks and curb and gutter, from New Mexico highway 404 to
17 Dos Lagos boulevard in Anthony;

18 E. two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000)
19 to plan, survey, design, acquire rights of way, construct and
20 install lighting, sidewalks and other improvements for
21 various roads and the Dona Ana multi-use trail in and around
22 the village of Dona Ana;

23 F. five hundred ninety-five thousand dollars
24 (\$595,000) to acquire rights of way and plan, design and
25 construct roadway improvements, including curb and gutter,

1 upgrade utilities and construct flood control measures on the
2 east side of Las Cruces;

3 G. one hundred fifty-five thousand dollars
4 (\$155,000) to acquire rights of way and easements and plan,
5 design and construct drainage improvements to Calle de
6 Picacho in Mesilla;

7 H. one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars
8 (\$125,000) to plan, design, survey and construct roadway and
9 drainage improvements for Fort McClane road and McRae avenue
10 in Radium Springs;

11 I. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
12 plan, design, survey and construct roadway improvements on
13 Baker, Corea and Kingman streets and Derry avenue in Rincon;
14 and

15 J. two hundred forty-five thousand dollars
16 (\$245,000) to plan, design and construct roadway and drainage
17 improvements, including geotechnical investigation,
18 environmental planning and permitting, topographic and
19 right-of-way surveys, wheelchair ramps, sidewalks and curb
20 and gutter, to Calle Diaz and Calle Morroco roads in Anapra
21 in Sunland Park.

22 SECTION 9. EDDY COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS--APPROPRIATIONS.--

23 Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, the following amounts are
24 appropriated for the following purposes in Eddy county:

25 A. three hundred ninety-five thousand dollars

1 (\$395,000) to plan, design, acquire rights of way and
2 construct a relief route around the southeast side of
3 Carlsbad from United States highway 285 across the Pecos
4 river to United States highway 62/180; and

5 B. six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) to
6 plan, design, acquire rights of way and construct a relief
7 route around the southwest side of Carlsbad.

8 SECTION 10. GRANT COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS--

9 APPROPRIATIONS.--Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, the
10 following amounts are appropriated for the following purposes
11 in Grant county:

12 A. one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000)
13 to survey and design engineering services to improve Airport
14 road from the intersection with United States highway 180
15 west approximately two and one-half miles to the end of the
16 pavement at the intersection with Ridge road; and

17 B. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
18 plan, design, acquire easements and rights of way and make
19 federal Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 and drainage
20 improvements to McKee and Erie streets; Bard street from
21 Steyskal street to McKee street; Walnut, Rosemary, Grant and
22 North streets; North Foy street; and Copper and Alta Vista
23 streets in Bayard.

24 SECTION 11. HIDALGO COUNTY ROAD PROJECT--

25 APPROPRIATION.--Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, one

1 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is appropriated for
2 expenditure in fiscal years 2020 and 2021 to purchase and
3 equip road maintenance vehicles for Hidalgo county.

4 SECTION 12. LEA COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS--APPROPRIATIONS.--

5 Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, the following amounts are
6 appropriated for the following purposes in Lea county:

7 A. two hundred ninety-five thousand dollars
8 (\$295,000) to widen, overlay asphalt, stripe and install
9 signage on Kansas road from New Mexico highway 18 to Bensing
10 road; and

11 B. two hundred ninety-five thousand dollars
12 (\$295,000) to widen and overlay pavement on the Eunice bypass
13 and 6th street from Main street to Avenue Q.

14 SECTION 13. LINCOLN COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS--

15 APPROPRIATIONS.--Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, the
16 following amounts are appropriated for the following purposes
17 in Lincoln county:

18 A. one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000)
19 to plan, design and construct three miles of repavement of
20 county roads; and

21 B. five hundred ninety-five thousand dollars
22 (\$595,000) to pave Country Club drive from New Mexico highway
23 48 to Cree Meadows drive in Ruidoso.

24 SECTION 14. LUNA COUNTY ROAD PROJECT--APPROPRIATION.--

25 Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, one hundred forty thousand

1 dollars (\$140,000) is appropriated to plan, design, construct
2 and improve roads in Luna county.

3 SECTION 15. MCKINLEY COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS--
4 APPROPRIATIONS.--Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, the
5 following amounts are appropriated for the following purposes
6 in McKinley county:

7 A. four hundred forty-five thousand dollars
8 (\$445,000) to reconstruct Deer Springs road;

9 B. one hundred forty-six thousand nine hundred
10 dollars (\$146,900) to plan, engineer, design and construct,
11 including archaeological and environmental studies, two miles
12 of Burnt Corn road and three miles of Turtle Butte Circle
13 road and emergency access roads for the Iyanbito Chapter of
14 the Navajo Nation; and

15 C. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
16 plan, design and construct road improvements for four miles
17 of Sunset valley and eight miles of west Tsayatoh community
18 roads.

19 SECTION 16. OTERO COUNTY ROAD PROJECT--APPROPRIATION.--
20 Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, two hundred thousand
21 dollars (\$200,000) is appropriated to reconstruct Cider Mills
22 Farm road from Haynes Canyon to High Rolls in Otero county.

23 SECTION 17. QUAY COUNTY ROAD PROJECT--APPROPRIATION.--
24 Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, two hundred fifteen
25 thousand dollars (\$215,000) is appropriated for expenditure

1 in fiscal years 2020 and 2021 to purchase and equip a roadway
2 maintenance vehicle for Tucumcari.

3 SECTION 18. RIO ARRIBA COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS--
4 APPROPRIATIONS.--Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, the
5 following amounts are appropriated for the following purposes
6 in Rio Arriba county:

7 A. three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000)
8 to plan, design, perform environmental testing and construct
9 or rehabilitate east Pueblo street, including sidewalks, in
10 Espanola;

11 B. one hundred forty-eight thousand seven hundred
12 fifty dollars (\$148,750) to plan, design, construct and
13 complete improvements to various county roads; and

14 C. two hundred forty thousand dollars (\$240,000)
15 to install nine hundred fifty linear feet of curb and gutter
16 and sidewalks on both sides of Silkey Way street in Espanola.

17 SECTION 19. ROOSEVELT COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS--
18 APPROPRIATIONS.--Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, the
19 following amounts are appropriated for the following purposes
20 in Roosevelt county:

21 A. three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to
22 maintain and repair county roads; and

23 B. one hundred ninety thousand dollars (\$190,000)
24 for expenditure in fiscal years 2020 and 2021 to purchase
25 police vehicles for the Portales police department.

1 SECTION 20. SAN JUAN COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS--
2 APPROPRIATIONS.--Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, the
3 following amounts are appropriated for the following purposes
4 in San Juan county:

5 A. one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000)
6 to develop alternative routes if Five Mile bridge is closed;

7 B. two hundred ninety-five thousand dollars
8 (\$295,000) for expenditure in fiscal years 2020 and 2021 to
9 purchase and equip heavy road machinery, such as a road
10 grader, for the Lake Valley chapter of the Navajo Nation;

11 C. two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000)
12 to plan, design, build and maintain county roads;

13 D. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
14 plan, design, build and maintain streets in Bloomfield;

15 E. two hundred forty-five thousand dollars
16 (\$245,000) to plan, design, build and maintain streets in
17 Farmington; and

18 F. five hundred ninety-five thousand dollars
19 (\$595,000) to plan, design, construct, repair and maintain
20 streets in Farmington.

21 SECTION 21. SAN MIGUEL COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS--
22 APPROPRIATIONS.--Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, the
23 following amounts are appropriated for the following purposes
24 in San Miguel county:

25 A. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan,

1 design, engineer and construct road and drainage improvements
2 to various county roads in Conchas Dam;

3 B. one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000)
4 to plan, design and fabricate a bridge across the river to
5 irrigated lands on the acequia de Seguras; and

6 C. two hundred fifteen thousand dollars (\$215,000)
7 for expenditure in fiscal years 2020 and 2021 to purchase and
8 equip a roadway maintenance vehicle for Las Vegas.

9 SECTION 22. SANDOVAL COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS--
10 APPROPRIATIONS.--Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, the
11 following amounts are appropriated for the following purposes
12 in Sandoval county:

13 A. three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for
14 expenditure in fiscal years 2020 and 2021 to construct
15 drainage and grade the roadway to and parking lot of Walatowa
16 charter high school at the Pueblo of Jemez;

17 B. five hundred ninety-five thousand dollars
18 (\$595,000) to plan, design, construct and improve Calle
19 Barrio Nuevo and Camino Don Tomas, including paving,
20 sidewalks and curbs and gutters, in Bernalillo; and

21 C. five hundred ninety-five thousand dollars
22 (\$595,000) to design and construct roadway improvements,
23 including water and wastewater utility improvements, to King
24 boulevard between Unser boulevard and Wilpett drive in
25 Rio Rancho.

1 SECTION 23. SANTA FE COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS--

2 APPROPRIATIONS.--Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, the
3 following amounts are appropriated for the following purposes
4 in Santa Fe county:

5 A. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
6 acquire rights of way and to plan, design, construct and
7 install lighting, sidewalk and bicycle path improvements and
8 road improvements on Lopez lane;

9 B. one hundred forty-five thousand dollars
10 (\$145,000) to chip seal approximately three and one-half
11 miles of feeder roads along Rancho Alegre road;

12 C. two hundred ninety-seven thousand five hundred
13 dollars (\$297,500) to plan, design and construct road
14 improvements within the Eldorado subdivision;

15 D. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
16 acquire rights of way and to plan, design, construct and
17 install lighting and road and sidewalk improvements and
18 bicycle lanes on Harrison road from Cerrillos road to Agua
19 Fria street in Santa Fe;

20 E. sixty-five thousand dollars (\$65,000) to plan
21 and design a road noise mitigation project on United States
22 highway 84/285 between the north and south opera exits north
23 of Santa Fe;

24 F. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
25 acquire rights of way and to plan, design and construct

1 bicycle and pedestrian improvements and road improvements on
2 Camino Entrada in Santa Fe;

3 G. one hundred thirty-two thousand five hundred
4 dollars (\$132,500) to design and construct bicycle paths in
5 senate district 25 in Santa Fe;

6 H. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
7 acquire rights of way and to plan, design and construct
8 bicycle and pedestrian improvements and road improvements on
9 Pacheco street and Siringo road in Santa Fe;

10 I. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
11 plan, design and construct pedestrian improvements on Pacheco
12 street and Siringo road in city council district 2 in
13 Santa Fe; and

14 J. one hundred ninety-five thousand dollars
15 (\$195,000) to acquire rights of way and to plan, design and
16 construct lighting and road, sidewalk and bicycle
17 improvements in various locations in Santa Fe.

18 SECTION 24. SIERRA COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS--
19 APPROPRIATIONS.--Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, the
20 following amounts are appropriated for the following purposes
21 in Sierra county:

22 A. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
23 purchase road equipment for the Sierra county road
24 department; and

25 B. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to

1 acquire easements and rights of way, conduct environmental
2 and archaeological studies and plan, design and construct
3 street and drainage improvements in Williamsburg.

4 SECTION 25. SOCORRO COUNTY ROAD PROJECT--
5 APPROPRIATION.--Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, two
6 hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) is appropriated to design
7 the complete reconstruction of Bullock avenue from California
8 street to Lopezville road in Socorro.

9 SECTION 26. TAOS COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS--
10 APPROPRIATIONS.--Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, the
11 following amounts are appropriated for the following purposes
12 in Taos county:

13 A. one hundred forty-eight thousand seven hundred
14 fifty dollars (\$148,750) to plan, design, construct and
15 complete repavement of seven miles to the existing Blueberry
16 Hill road in El Prado;

17 B. one hundred forty-eight thousand seven hundred
18 fifty dollars (\$148,750) to plan, design, construct and
19 complete improvements to Cabresto road in Questa; and

20 C. one hundred forty-eight thousand seven hundred
21 fifty dollars (\$148,750) to replace existing drainage
22 structures on Camino del Medio in Taos.

23 SECTION 27. TORRANCE COUNTY ROAD PROJECT--
24 APPROPRIATION.--Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, one
25 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) is appropriated to

1 purchase and equip a double steel roller and other equipment
2 for the Torrance county road department.

3 SECTION 28. VALENCIA COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS--
4 APPROPRIATIONS.--Pursuant to Section 1 of this act, the
5 following amounts are appropriated for the following purposes
6 in Valencia county:

7 A. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
8 construct a new roadway, including paving and striping, of
9 Don Sosteno road between Don Pasqual road and New Mexico
10 highway 314;

11 B. three hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$360,000)
12 to rehabilitate pavement, sidewalks and striping on Eastside
13 School road between River road and Serafin road; and

14 C. one hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000)
15 to rehabilitate Amor court, including sidewalks and striping,
16 from Diebold road to the end of the cul de sac in Peralta.
