## 1 A MEMORIAL 2 PROCLAIMING FEBRUARY 5, 2020 "ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE AWARENESS 3 DAY" IN THE SENATE. 4 5 WHEREAS, Alzheimer's disease, the most common cause of 6 dementia, is a degenerative, fatal disease of the brain that destroys mental and physical functions; and 7 WHEREAS, Alzheimer's disease is not a part of the normal 8 9 aging process; and 10 WHEREAS, there is no known cure, treatment or prevention for Alzheimer's disease; and 11 WHEREAS, every sixty-five seconds, someone in America 12 develops Alzheimer's disease; and 13 WHEREAS, an estimated five million eight hundred 14 15 thousand Americans now live with Alzheimer's disease; and WHEREAS, as estimated forty-one thousand people in 16 New Mexico are currently living with Alzheimer's disease; and 17 WHEREAS, by 2025, New Mexico is projected to experience 18 a thirty percent growth rate of people with this devastating 19 20 disease; and WHEREAS, by 2025, New Mexico will have an estimated 21 fifty-three thousand residents diagnosed with Alzheimer's 22 disease; 23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 24 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that February 5, 2020 be proclaimed 25
