SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 260 appropriates \$250 thousand from the general fund to the Cultural Affairs Department to expand local community outreach programs.

There is no effective date of this bill. It is assumed that the effective date is 90 days following adjournment of the Legislature.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$250 thousand contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2021 shall revert to the general fund.

The Cultural Affairs Department states that the appropriation would be used as additional funds to the operating budget for the Museum of Indian Art and Culture or other department existing facilities to meet the mandate of SB260.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The Cultural Affairs Department states that if the intent of this language is for the department to contract with an organization to provide services not within the purview of the department, then specific language regarding the services/programs should be added to the legislation.
