appointed and qualified. The secretary may fill any 1 2 vacancies on the committee for the remainder of an unexpired 3 term. D. The committee may elect a chair and such other 4 officers as it deems necessary to carry out its duties. 5 Ε. Members of the committee are entitled to 6 receive per diem and mileage as provided for nonsalaried 7 8 public officers in the Per Diem and Mileage Act and shall receive no other compensation, perquisite or allowance. 9 F. Representation on the committee shall resemble 10 the demographics of New Mexico in conjunction with the three 11 congressional districts.
