SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Memorial 5 requests the General Services Department and the historic preservation division of the Cultural Affairs Department to study and develop recommendations for memorializing and preserving the birthplace of Dolores Heurta in Dawson, New Mexico. HM5 notes that legislators have expressed an interest in preserving Dawson and possibly creating a museum.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

DCA reported HM5 would have no financial impact on the agency but GSD noted the study will require staff time and a potential contract with an outside firm but did not provide a cost estimate. Therefore, the operating budget cost is considered minimal.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

DCA notes:
