Single User Restrooms (Gender Neutral)

- International Building Code (IBC) 2902.1.2; Designers can choose to use male and female plumbing fixtures per the IBC or provide single-user toilet rooms.
- It is up to the owner, potentially the district to direct the designer to build male/female or single-user toilet rooms.
- Either choice does not lower the number of required fixtures.
- The overall gross square footage of a school facility may increase slightly.
- For many years the building code in certain occupancies, required a Unisex toilet room. This was a
 toilet room separate from the main restroom. It had a single entry, a lockable door and either
 gender could use the restroom. Typically, each school would have one or two, the number of
 required male and female restrooms triggered the requirement for a Unisex Toilet room.
- The "gender natural" or as referred to in the building code, "Single-user" restrooms are lockable stalls within a shared space.

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
