


New Mexico Outcomes: Pre and Post Implementation

Data from each of the AOC Pretrial implementation sites was pulled to provide a comparison of safety rates prior to implementation and post implementation. The charts below reflect the percentage of defendants who had a case filed, with a disposition of all charges, that did not have new charges (Safety Rate) or new violent charges (No NVCA Rate) filed during the pretrial phase of their case.

Pre and Post Implementation No NVCA Rate




Statewide Outcomes

The New Mexico AOC Pretrial Justice Division is working to develop and implement state standards and practices with support from the National Institute of Corrections (NIC) and the National Association of Pretrial Services Agencies (NAPSA).

The chart reflects pretrial outcomes for the following jurisdictions:

- 1st Judicial District
- 3rd Judicial District
- 6th Judicial District
- 11th Judicial District
- 13th Judicial District

Using the NIC *“Measuring What Matters: Outcome and Performance Measures for the Pretrial Services Field, 2nd Edition”* outcomes are defined as:

1. **Appearance Rate:** The percentage of released defendants who make all scheduled court appearances pending the case disposition.
2. **Public Safety Rate:** The percentage of released defendants who are not charged with a new offense pending the case's disposition .
3. **New Violent Criminal Activity Rate (NVCA):** The percentage of released defendants who are not charged with a new violent criminal offense.

New Criminal Activity

A review and analysis of data for FY23 found that 77% of defendants did not have new charges filed during the pretrial phase of the case.

A sample (1,163 cases) of the 23% of cases that did have new charges filed found that less than 1% had a new charge for a 1st degree felony. This chart reflects the highest charge category for cases that had new charges filed during the pretrial phase of the initial case.
