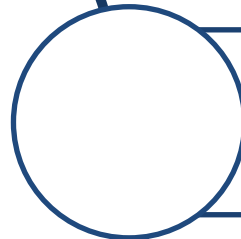

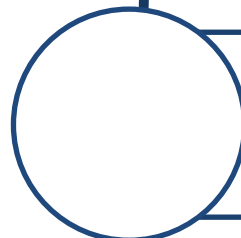
Who We Are
