

Example of technology available:

Our units are programmable and are cellular based, so internet services is not needed. We have a wrist pendant and a pocket device. The devices provide support and safety umbrella and pair students with clinicians and staff with a simple click of a button. Later we will utilize our avatar and digital assistant, Addison.

How it works:

Behavioral health providers will be able to work with those students who present with increased symptoms of depression, anxiety, grief, social isolation among other presenting behaviors. The student will be assigned an ECG device during school hours, and they will be able to press the button to receive assistance from LCDF staff.

Collaboration between Homegrown Companies:

La Clinica de Familia is a cornerstone of healthcare in Southern New Mexico, providing care to nearly 33,000 unique patients annually and offering the most robust behavioral health specialties under a Federally Qualified Health Center in the state. While La Clinica de Familia leads the direct care, Electronic Caregiver supports this work by providing advanced technology that streamlines care coordination and enhances monitoring capabilities.

There are single parent, single car families who stress and struggle when they have a pressing health matter such as a cold, diabetes, asthma, epilepsy, vaccines, physicals, safety concerns, behavioral health, or others. In the school-based health centers, this partnership ensures timely interventions, efficient monitoring, and better health outcomes for students, all without the need for families to struggle with access barriers such as transportation and taking time off of work
