


Vacancies by Discipline








RECOMMENDATIONS FOR TEACHER RECRUITMENT/RETENTION

1. Remove unnecessary barriers to licensure (Increased NES Standards)
2. Create an incentive program for students interested in pursuing careers in education. (College scholarships with NM work requirement)
3. Support teacher pipeline programs like Educators Rising NM, EA's to Teachers, Second Career programs etc.
4. Compensate teachers at a salary level comparable to neighboring states.
5. Work with EPP programs to streamline licensure requirements.
