OUR HISTORY

School of Dreams Academy (SODA) is a New Mexico State Authorized Charter School located in Los Lunas, NM. SODA was the inspiration of Avilio (Lefty) Otero & Edna Otero. Teresa Ogas's parents envisioned and dreamed of a school with a different approach that would help students stay in school while providing them opportunities for a successful future. They wanted a school that would meet the needs of all children while providing them an opportunity to realize their dreams. Mr. Otero challenged his daughter, Teresa, her husband Michael, and Kathy Chavez, who was with YDI Valencia, to create a charter school in Valencia County. The school became a reality in August of 2009 in a commercial strip mall with about 55 students from 7th-9th grade. As time went on they eventually added secondary, elementary and PreK grades, due to the demand for these additional grades by the community, and they very quickly outgrew that facility. SODA now has an enrollment of approximately 600 students in grades PreK -12th.
