Proposed Work Plan

The Tobacco Settlement Revenue Oversight Committee (TSROC) was established pursuant to Section 2-19-1 NMSA 1978. TSROC is tasked with monitoring the use of tobacco settlement revenue, reviewing evaluations of programs receiving funding from tobacco settlement revenue and making recommendations for program funding and for changes in legislation regarding the use of tobacco settlement revenue.

In addition to its statutory duties, and as time permits, during the 2025 interim, TSROC will address the following topics:

- A. updates from agencies receiving funds;
- B. vaping legislation;
- C. retail licensing;
- D. how and why Senate Bill 20 (2025) failed to pass;
- E. funding enforcement through the Regulation and Licensing Department;
- F. progress of the Nicotine Use Prevention and Control Program through the Department of Health;
- G. review of available funds;
- H. review of the State Department of Justice settlement;
- I. preparation of recommendations to the Legislative Finance Committee for program funding levels based on that committee's program evaluation process; and
- J. make findings and recommendations, including proposed legislation, available to the legislature as part of the TSROC's final report.
