White Sands Overview

This map provides a detailed overview of the White Sands National Park area in New Mexico. The central feature is the White Sands National Park, highlighted in orange. 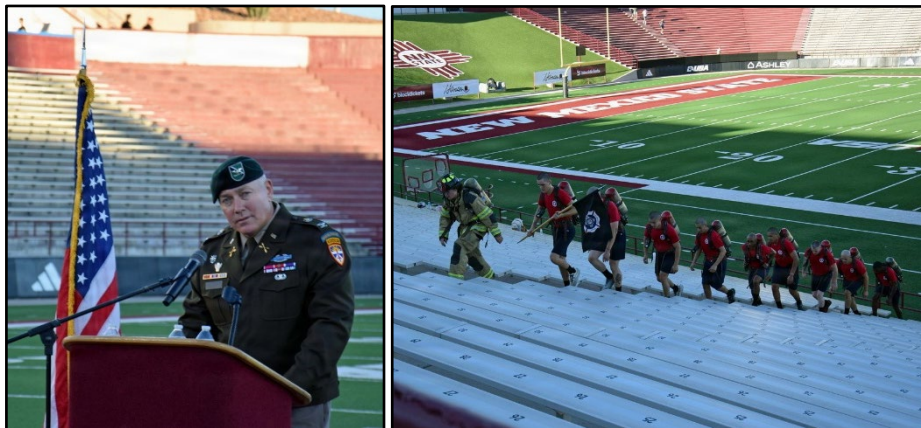

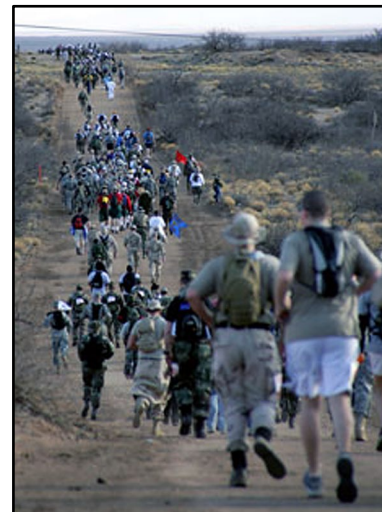
