

The Early College High School Model graduates students at near 100%


- o Eliminates gaps in demographic groups
- Most earn associates degrees and/or certifications along with their diploma
- Places them at an average \$5,000-\$12,000 economic advantage over their non-ECHS peers


#### **Best Practices**

- Students learn responsibility and self-motivation early


### **Current State of Dual Credit**


## **Doña County Population in Poverty According to KidsCount Data**








#### Good Jobs that Pay without a BA - New Mexico
