- Introduction –
- Good Morning Mr. Chairman and members of the committee. My name is Paul Briesh and I am the Vice President and General Manager of Baca Valley Telephone Co., Inc. and Sierra Communications, Inc., headquartered in Des Moines, NM. Baca Valley currently serves approximately 2600 square miles and 525 customers, in Union and Colfax counties. We have 31 employees, which includes a 24 x 7 Network Operations Center “NOC”, and have an annual payroll of nearly \$1,400,000.00. Our total investment in cable and equipment over the past 8 years is over \$5,000,000.00. Our NOC gives our customers 24 x 7 peace of mind that someone will answer their call and give them the help they need. To help keep people employed in Des Moines our NOC also answers emergency and after-hour calls for 2 Rural Electric Cooperatives and 3 other small Telecommunications Companies.
- History of Baca Valley Telephone Co., Inc. Growth from Crank Phones in the beginning until now.
  - 1-Past Fiber Optic and Broadband deployment includes over 400 miles of fiber optic cable. Currently working on 6<sup>th</sup> Loan Application with RUS, which will add another 105 miles of cable.
  - 2-We currently serve 2 customers with fiber, who do not have electricity. After our upcoming RUS Fiber Project, we will add an additional 5 customers who do not have electricity. [See photo].
  - 3-We will soon connect our fiber to Level 3-Zayo for protection and Broadband redundancy and gain 2 more Gb’s of bandwidth.
  - 4-We currently serve 31 remote equipment cabinets, some as far away as 55 miles, with fiber and then connect to some customers with copper connections. Over 90 % of our customers now have 10 Mg x 1 Mg Internet service.
  - 5-Our focus is to keep pushing fiber out farther to our customers, which will give them as much as 1 Gb of Internet. Over 30% of our customers do not have access to reliable Cellphone Service due to terrain. Dial Tone for E911 is still very important to us and our customers. Our Internet is not Capped, nor will it buffer.

6-We are seeing some of our younger people and kids moving back. Our schools are some of the best in New Mexico and our communities are fantastic places to raise kids! Our employees are involved in our communities. They are volunteer EMT's, Firefighters, School Board Members, Village Council Members, Coaches, etc.

- Role and history of Sierra Communications and De-Regulated services
  - 1-Partners with area Schools, Libraries, Health Centers, Businesses and Communities.
  - 2-Sierra installed fiber cable at all 7 locations in Raton as well as here in Cimarron, at no cost to the schools.
  - 3-Provides Dial Tone, Internet, Security Alarms and Cameras, PBX Phone Systems, 2-Way Radios, and Fiber Cable to Philmont Scout Ranch, Vermejo Park Ranch and NRA Whittington Center, as well as in the Cities of Raton and Cimarron.
  
- Other Small Telephone Company mentality and expansion energies are put into Broadband. We are doing our part towards Economic Development and making Rural New Mexico a great place to live.
  
- Obstacles
  - 1-Financing and RUS timelines.
  - 2-Cost of construction
    - \$22,000.00 to over \$35,000.00 per mile.
  - 3-Right-Of-Way-
    - BLM, BIA, DOT, State Land Office, Counties, Army Corp of Engineers and Land Owners
  - 4-Environmental and Archeological Surveys and extreme costs!!
  - 5-Weather-We are often called the "Antarctic of New Mexico", by State Police, DOT and EMS.
  
- What is in store for Rural New Mexico and the future of Fiber Optic and associated equipment upgrades and the **value and importance of the NM State USF Fund**. We still have a lot more to do and we are all aware that if we "Lose our Schools, we lose our towns".
  
- As you have noticed, we do have many employees. This is due to our commitment to Customer Service and Economic Development and the thankful fact we are BUSY!

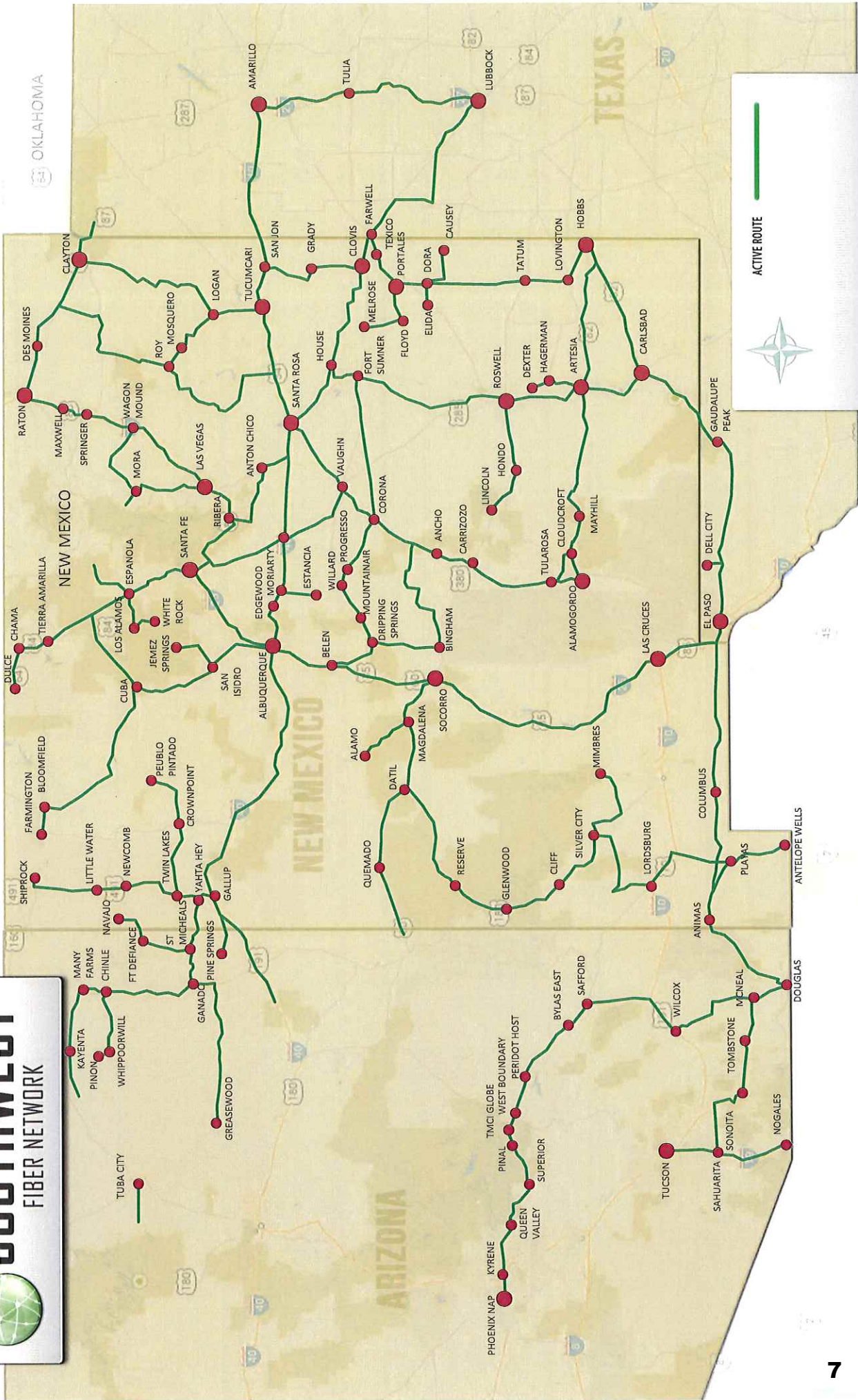
