Training Opportunities for HVAC Maintenance

Training Providers for HVAC Maintenance

- CES hosts the Facilities Manager Workshop
 - Regional HVAC Maintenance Training
 - Next opportunity in Eunice for Chavez, Eddy and Lea counties
- Local 49 Union; HVAC maintenance training to members
- Associated General Contractors; Building Operators Certification
- Construction Industries Division (CID) does not train HVAC personnel

Three Year Maintenance Agreement

- Contractually, PSFA obligates the mechanical contractor to service and maintain the HVAC unit for three years.
- Quarterly, semi-annual or annual maintenance, inspections and testing services to ensure operational integrity of all HVAC, Water Conditioning, and Control Systems
- At project close out the installer must provide training, operations manual or videos
