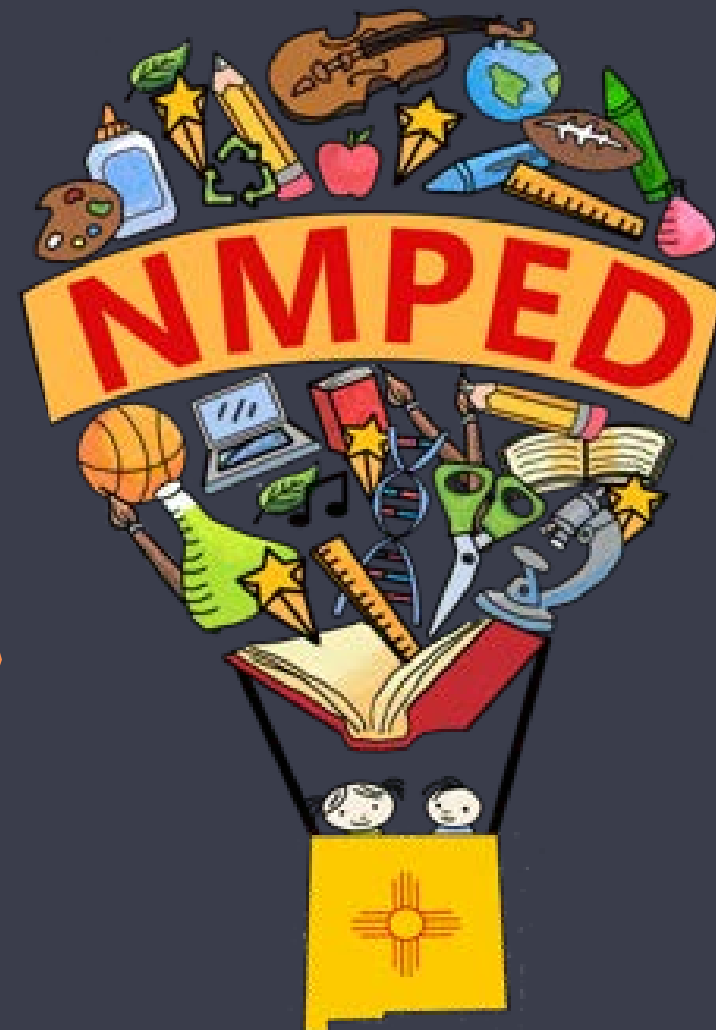

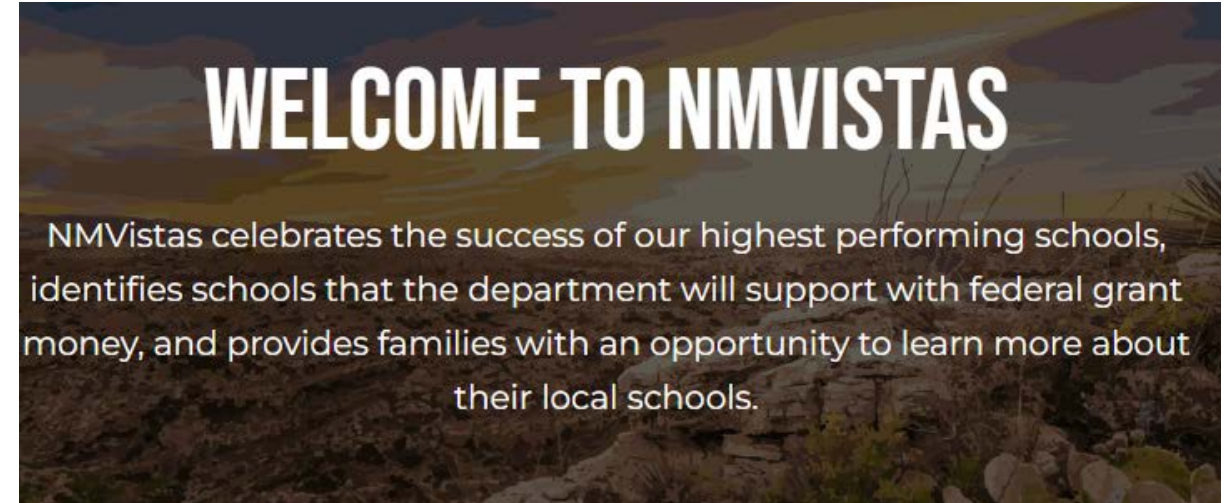

# NM Differentiated Systems of Support



**The NM Differentiated Systems of Support is designed to assist leaders in developing structures to support planning and implementation of transformational strategies.**

- District and School Support and Readiness Assessments
- School Improvement Performance Coach
- Professional Learning for district and school teams, grounded in common themes of the findings of the readiness assessment
- Grant funding to support evidence-based interventions

# Plan Moving Forward

- **Host Regional Meetings.** PED will host regional meetings to talk about the accountability model and our Differentiated Systems of Support over the next 2 months.
- **Create Advisory Group.** We are creating a Data Accountability Working and Advisory Group moving forward.
- **Award Funding.** Award by July 1, 2023.
- **Support Schools.** In order to meet the tight timeline for allocation and spend, PED staff will be supporting schools to deploy the resources.

<b>February – May 2024</b>	Implementation and Monitoring of 90 Day Plan and Development of Draft Annual Plan for SY 2024-2025

# Potential Resource or Policy Needs
