Teacher & Principal Quality

- Licensure
 - Teacher-in-Residency Program
 - ✓ Joint Partnership with Northern NM Community College & Espanola School District
 - ✓ 1 year program
 - ✓ Students who already have Bachelors, Masters
 - ✓ Working in schools as core academic teachers
 - ✓ Working as teachers allows this as student teaching time
 - ✓ Mentor teachers (1 full-time in Espanola, 1 parttime through JADE)
 - ✓ Students pay for their tuition etc.
 - ✓ Students receive \$5,000.00 incentive award upon completion & certification

- Native American Language/Culture
 - Jicarilla Apache Nation 1st to sign MOA with NM SDE
 - ✓ Certified teachers
 - ✓ Developed instructional materials
 - > Revised/updated MOA
 - Waiting for guidance on how this will be implemented
- Curriculum
 - > Participating on curriculum development
 - MMPED Native Social Studies Curriculum On HOLD
 - ✓ Museum of Indian Arts & Culture
 - > Developed Jicarilla Apache Language/Cultural materials

 - Northern NM Community College Teacher Track & Possibly Voc/Tech Track
- Special Education MOA
 - > Developed for Dulce Schools
 - > Approved schools' legal counsel

 - Board President of Dulce Schools requested JADE to conduct an evaluation of their schools for IEA implementation
