Statewide Data Integration

ICASA Work FY 2020

- Documented the business processes, work-flows, and technical architectures SID process.
- Developed and demonstrated a pilot application for the demonstration of integrated data from several detention centers statewide.
- Developed code to extract the DPS-approved prototype SID data set from the NMCJIS system, and created a data set from that data in the NM DataXChange.

ICASA Work FY 2021

- Partnering with Administrative Office of the District Attorneys & Judicial Information to pass and match SID information
- Continue work on integrated data from several detention centers statewide



Crime Reduction Grants

Data Integration Grants FY 2020 - 2021

- In FY 20, convened NMSC Grants Committee who awarded \$377,150 in criminal justice data-sharing grants, of which 6 projects were rolled into FY 2021.

CJCC	Project in Brief
1st	Notification system and dashboards for pretrial, courts, and jail stakeholders. Uploading docket info to DataXchange.
2nd	Integrating behavioral health data with existing CJ data flows.
8th	User interface for inmate admits and releases.
11th	Connecting Socrata and a variety of other law enforcement data systems.
12th	Scheduling Application for court appearances tied into DataXchange.
13rd	In the process of joining forces with the 12th for a similar application.
