



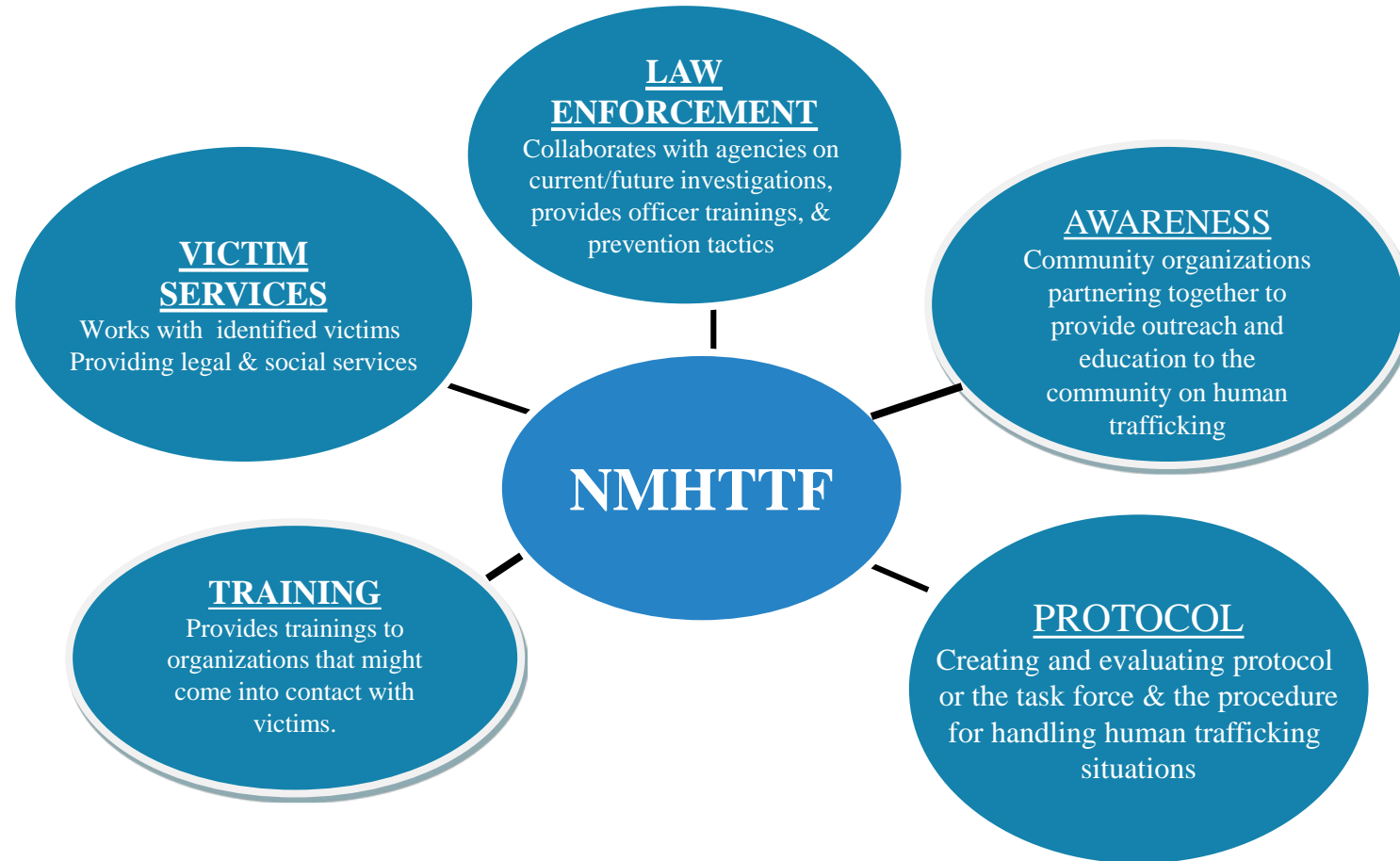

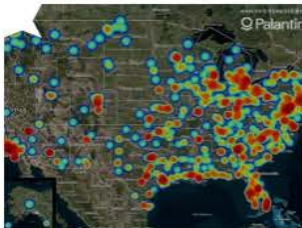




Human Trafficking

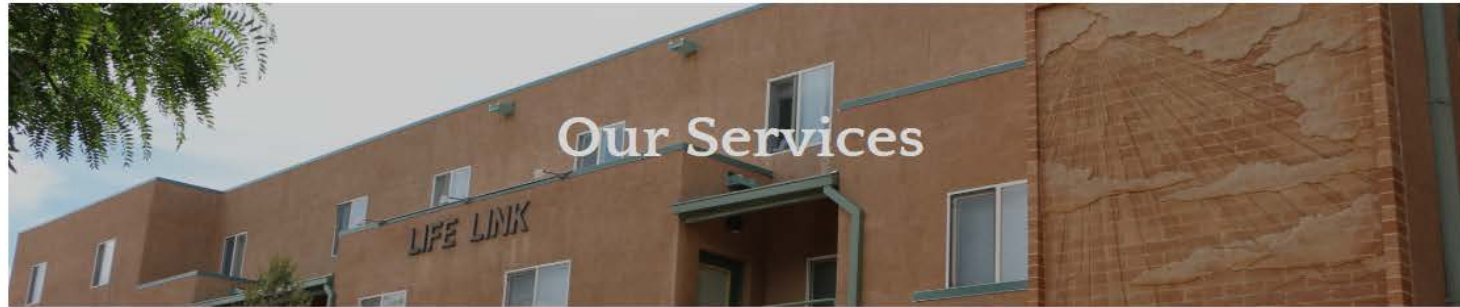

Anti-Human Trafficking Initiative

The Life Link's Anti-Human Trafficking Initiative, located in Santa Fe, is New Mexico's only comprehensive aftercare program for victims of human trafficking. Through partnerships with State government, law enforcement, community stakeholders, healthcare providers, and other interested crisis response, intensive case management, advocacy, benefit acquisition, mental health and substance abuse services, emergency and permanent supportive housing, trauma treatment, and linkage to additional community resources to assist them. The Anti-Human Trafficking Initiative team also provides consultation and training to law enforcement and behavioral health professionals on successful strategies for working with the population. The Life Link's program has received referrals from around the country and is gaining a national reputation for development and implementation of a best-practices approach for working with human trafficking victims. groups, the Initiative strives to provide rights-based, wraparound care to meet the myriad needs of rescued victims as they navigate the difficult road to recovery.

NMSA 30-52-1. Human trafficking

A. Human trafficking consists of a person knowingly:

- (1) **recruiting, soliciting, enticing, transporting or obtaining** by any means another person with the intent or knowledge that **force, fraud or coercion** will be used to subject the person to labor, services or commercial sexual activity;
- (2) **recruiting, soliciting, enticing, transporting or obtaining by any means** a person **under the age of eighteen years** with the intent or knowledge that the person will be caused to engage in commercial sexual activity; or
- (3) benefiting, financially or by receiving anything of value, from the labor, services or commercial sexual activity of another person with the knowledge that force, fraud or coercion was used to obtain the labor, services or commercial sexual activity.

B. The attorney general and the district attorney in the county of jurisdiction have concurrent jurisdiction to enforce the provisions of this section.

C. Whoever commits human trafficking is guilty of a third degree felony; except if the victim is under the age of:

(1) sixteen, the person is guilty of a second degree felony; or

(2) thirteen, the person is guilty of a first degree felony.

D. Prosecution pursuant to this section shall not prevent prosecution pursuant to any other provision of the law when the conduct also constitutes a violation of that other provision.

E. In a prosecution pursuant to this section, a human trafficking victim shall not be charged with accessory to the crime of human trafficking.

F. A person convicted of human trafficking shall, in addition to any other punishment, be ordered to make restitution to the victim for the gross income or value of the victim's labor or services and any other actual damages in accordance with Section 31-17-1 NMSA 1978.

30-52-1.1. Human trafficking; civil remedy for human trafficking victims

A. A human trafficking victim may bring a civil action in any court of competent jurisdiction against an alleged human trafficker for actual damages, compensatory damages, punitive damages, injunctive relief or any other appropriate relief. Where the court finds that a defendant's actions were willful and malicious, the court may award treble damages to the plaintiff. A prevailing plaintiff is also entitled to recover reasonable attorney fees and costs.

B. A civil action pursuant to this section shall be forever barred unless the action is filed within ten years from the date on which:

(1) the defendant's human trafficking actions occurred; or

(2) the victim attains eighteen years of age if the victim was a minor when the defendant's actions occurred.

Human Trafficking: What Is It?

Sex Trafficking: Commercial sex act induced by force, fraud or coercion, or in which person performing the act is under age 18.

- *Victims can be found working in massage parlors, brothels, strip clubs, escort services*

Labor Trafficking: Using force, fraud or coercion to recruit, harbor, transport, obtain or employ a person for labor or services in **involuntary servitude, peonage, debt bondage or slavery**

- *Victims can be found in domestic situations as nannies or maids, sweatshop factories, janitorial jobs, construction sites, farm work, restaurants, panhandling*

Human Trafficking reaches every race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, socioeconomic group, and demographic.

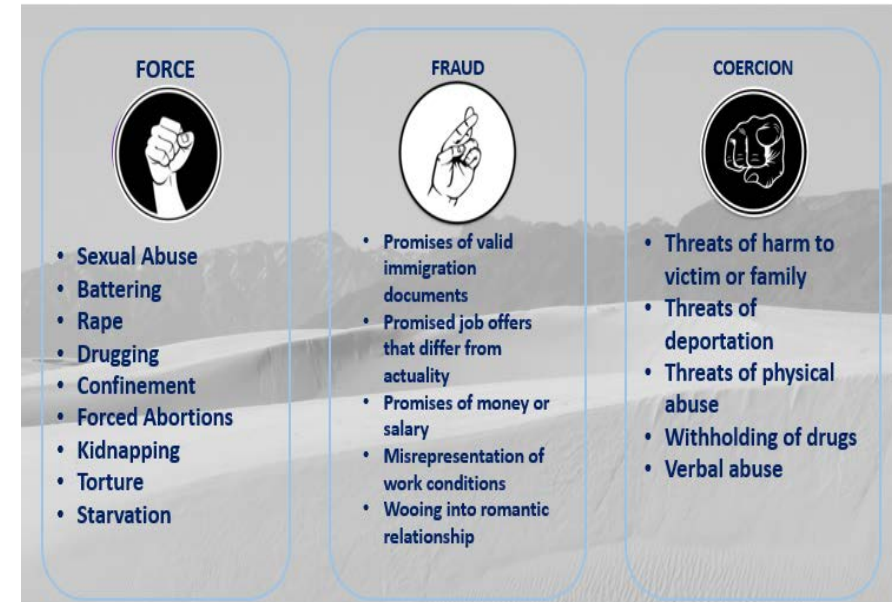
There is no such thing as a willing child prostitute!

How do Minors Become Victims of Trafficking?

- Running away and/or living on the streets and are forced to exchange sex for survival
- Recruitment or grooming by “Romeo” trafficker/pimp who convinces them that they love them and care for them.
- Kidnapped by “gorilla” trafficker/pimp and forced into the life.
- Gang-related prostitution
- A parent or family member(s) traffic their child(ren) for food, rent, money, drugs, and alcohol

How do Minors Become Victims of Trafficking?

- Tricked/seduced with false promises and dreams
- Economic abuse- forced to work and turn over all earned money
- Narcotics control- withholding drugs from victim unless they comply with demands



How do Minors Become Victims of Trafficking? (cont.)

- Threaten to harm victim or their family
- Threaten to call police as the victim has likely committed other crimes as well

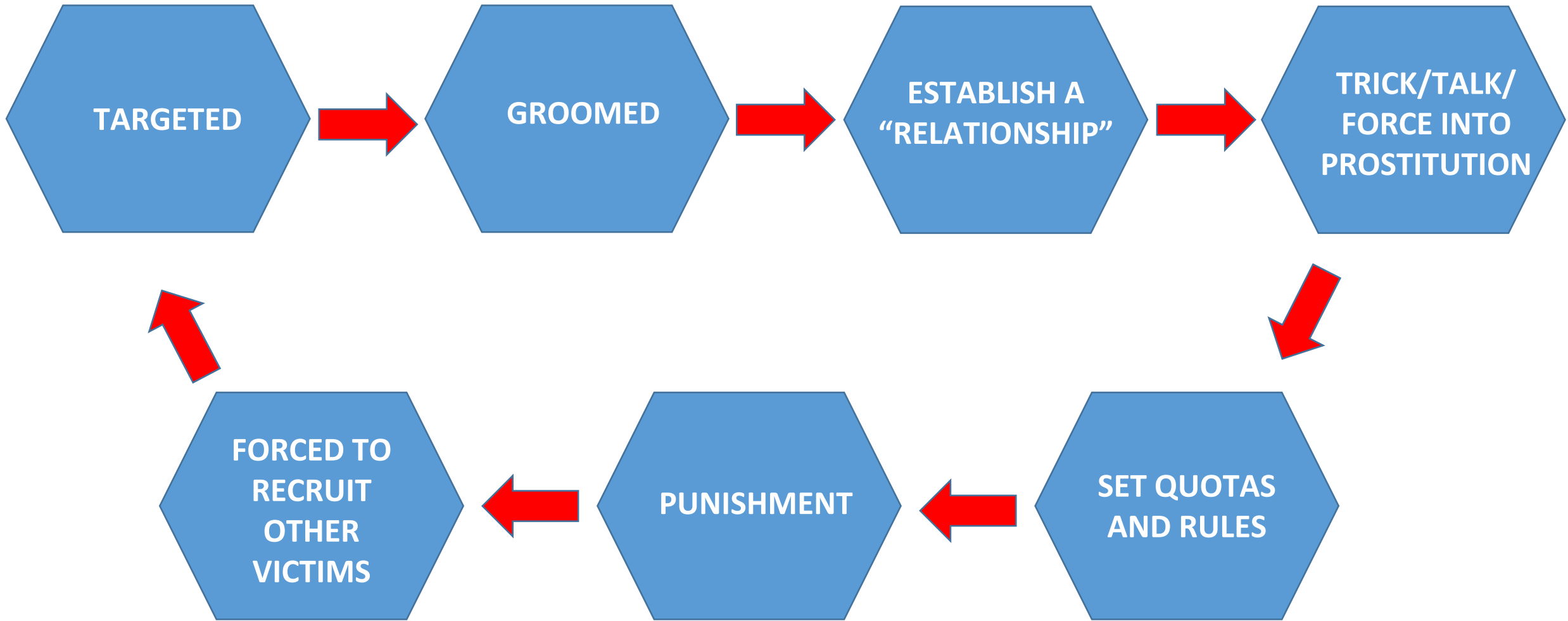

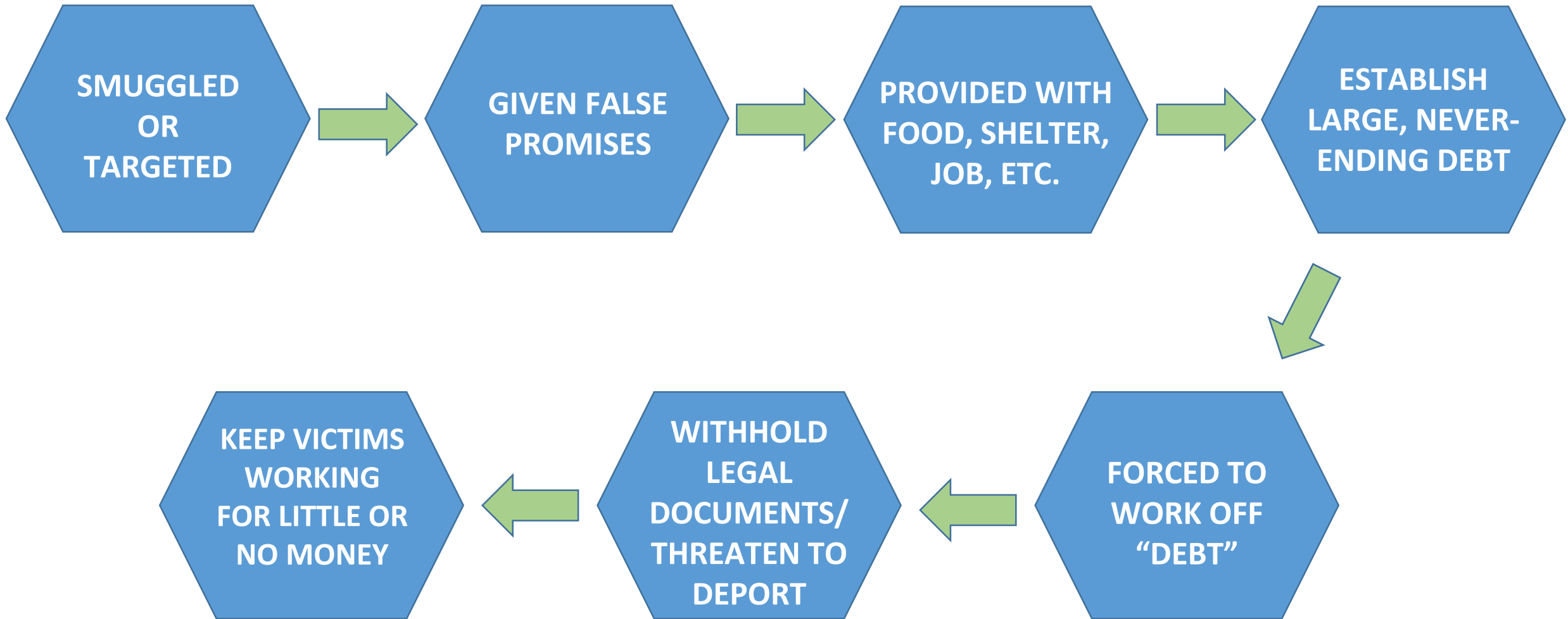

Who are the Traffickers?

- Anyone who benefits from the exploitation of a person both sex and labor
- Domestic or foreign
- Familial trafficking



Who are the Traffickers? (cont.)

Can be a boyfriend, father, mother, coach, teacher, even a peer

Not always organized criminals (although can be part of a larger criminal enterprise)

Familial Trafficking

“Familial Trafficking” can manifest itself in various ways such as:

- May sell the child/children for sex in exchange for money, rent, food, drugs, housing, employment, etc.
- May force their boyfriend/girlfriend to sell sexual favors
- May force children to work long hours in a family business
- May force the child to beg for money

Why Do Victims Stay?

- Kept isolated and activities restricted to prevent them from seeking help
- May be watched, escorted, or guarded by traffickers
- Traffickers may “coach” victims to answer questions
- Victims comply and don’t seek help because of fear due to threats of violence to self or family

Why Do Victims Stay?

- Fear of the law enforcement
- Fear of deportation, incarceration
- Unaware that they are a victim
- Fear of CYFD





Why Do Victims Stay? (cont.)

- May develop loyalties, positive feelings toward trafficker as a coping mechanism
- Stockholm Syndrome
- They have been groomed

Damage to the Victim

- Inhumane living conditions
- Poor sanitation
- Inadequate nutrition
- Poor personal hygiene
- Brutal physical, sexual, and emotional abuse
- Dangerous workplace conditions



Damage to the Victim

- General lack of quality medical care
- Sexually transmitted diseases, HIV/AIDS, pelvic pain, rectal trauma, and urinary difficulties
- Unwanted pregnancy, resulting from rape or prostitution
- Infertility from chronic untreated sexually transmitted infections or botched/unsafe abortions
- Substance abuse or addiction as a means of coping

Damage to the Victim

- Psychological trauma from daily mental abuse and torture
- Undetected or untreated diseases, such as diabetes or cancer
- Bruises, scars, and other signs of physical abuse and torture

Identifying Crime of Human Trafficking

Immediate concerns for law enforcement:

- *Identify when crimes of trafficking taking place*
- *Identify and distinguish between victims and perpetrators*
- *Stop crimes of trafficking in progress*
- *Manage victims of trafficking as witnesses*
- *Secure evidence of trafficking for prosecutions and trials*

Identifying Cases of Human Trafficking

Due to the covert nature of the crime, human trafficking can come to your attention indirectly through other violations such as:

- Prostitution
- Domestic Violence Crimes
- Drug Charges
- Runaways/Homeless
- Cases of Assault
- Curfew Violation
- Loitering/trespassing
- Cases of sexual abuse/neglect

Special agents with the New Mexico Office of the Attorney General arrested an Albuquerque man who they say was prostituting his 7-year-old female relative in exchange for “weed and pipes and other stuff.”

James Stewart, 37, is charged with human trafficking, abuse of a child, promoting prostitution and other crimes believed to have been committed over the past three years. He was found at Motel 76 on Candelaria NE early Thursday morning and booked into the county jail.

According to a criminal complaint filed in Metropolitan Court, the girl told investigators that Stewart would make her touch his friends’ (both male and female) genitalia in exchange for drugs. She said she “does not enjoy performing these sexual acts and is scared someone will touch her private parts.”

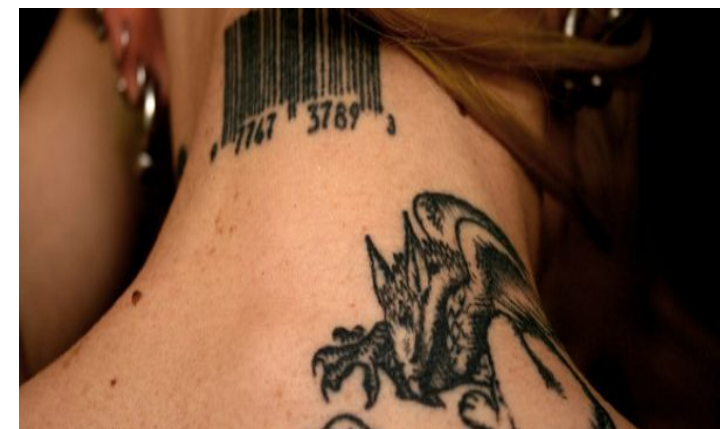
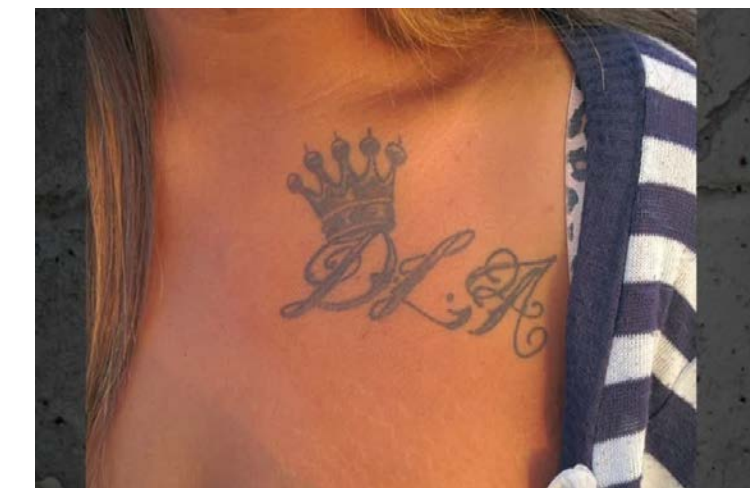

How many traffickers have we charged in NM from 2015-present? Include Arrests and Prosecutions of Offenders:

- 2015- No data (Funding started in October 2015)
- 2016- 7
- 2017- 9
 - From June 2017- June 2018, NMAGO and Task Force Affiliates conducted pro-active undercover sting operations, identifying a mass of individuals who responding to ads and offering money for sex.
- 2018- 65
- 2019- 35 (Through September 2019)

What do the sentences look like on the State vs. Federal?

- Federal sentence is a minimum 20 years if you are convicted of human/ sex trafficking.
- New Mexico penalties vary by age:
 - 16 and over, 3rd degree felony
 - 16 and under, 2nd degree felony
 - 13 and under, 1st degree felony

Successes in the creation of task forces:

Human Trafficking Task Force Website –

- Information on human trafficking to be disseminated to the NM Human Trafficking Task Force and the general public on our anti-human trafficking efforts.
- Training and outreach available
- Successes
