

  - Investment Officer does not have latitude to make unilateral investment decisions.

The Land Grant Permanent Fund and the Severance Tax Permanent Fund are structured to provide an annual distribution related to the size of the funds' corpus.

- 2. Protect the purchasing power of the corpus.
- 3. Provide growth to the annual distributions over time.
