

## THE VICS' NEW CAMPUS

Dear Friends,



On March 27, 2023, the Veteran Integration Centers broke ground on the first building of our new campus. This 20,000 square foot building will be the new VICs' transitional housing campus. This state-of-the-art structure will house 42 Veterans and up to 24 additional family members. It will also include private bedrooms and baths for each Veteran or Veteran family.

This new campus will be gated and fully secured. The beautiful landscaping will include a basketball court, jogging and walking path, playground, and climate-controlled storage warehouse. Because we value the relationship between our Veterans and their pets, our new campus will include an interactive dog park.

The second phase and building is scheduled to break ground in September of 2023. This building will be an 8,000 square foot building and will house approximately 15 additional full time VIC employees. These employees are critical in providing the wrap-around services to our Veterans. In addition, this building will have a wellness center and a food pantry.

The VIC has future plans for a third building that will serve as permanent affordable housing. This three-story permanent apartment complex will be an assortment of 1, 2 and 3 bedroom units totaling 33 apartment homes housing up to 100 Veterans and their families.

Special Thanks to the collaboration and support of the Veterans Administration, Bernalillo County, City of Albuquerque, State of New Mexico and Congresswoman Stansbury. With their support the VIC successfully secured pledges of over \$9.4 million towards these Capital Campaign efforts.\*
