# **Proposed PPRF Legislative Authorization Bill**

- ➤ 192 Total Entities Seeking PPRF Authorization
  - o 67 Municipalities
  - 26 Counties
  - 56 Public School Districts
  - 10 Higher Education Institutions
  - 4 Charter Schools
  - 4 State Agencies
  - 9 Tribal Entities
  - 16 Political Subdivisions/Special Districts
- Authorization Expires 2022




## NMFA Act - Legislative Authorization History

- > 1992 NMFA Act Created.
- > 1996 NMFA Act amended to include a cap of \$500,000 per loan for the equipment program.
- ➤ 2000 NMFA Act amended to require legislative authorization for all loans (up to \$500k cap).
- > 2003 NMFA Act amended to increase the cap to \$750,000 per loan for the equipment program.
- ➤ 2006 NMFA Act amended to current version, requiring legislative authorization for loans over \$1,000,000 (under \$1,000,000 considered part of our small loan program and do not need legislative authorization).




#### Growth of the Governmental Gross Receipts Tax - Fiscal Year to Fiscal Year






# **PPRF Loans Since Inception**






## Number of Loans Made Under \$3 Million






## Loans Under \$3 Million - % of Total Loans Made
