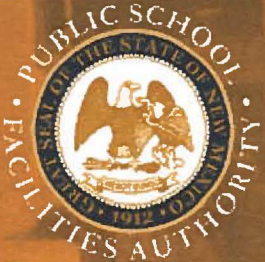
- Wide Area Network (Cat1 - fiber)
- Network Equipment (Cat2)
- **Support** for broadband infrastructure upgrades:
 - Funding (E-rate + PSCOC funding = 80% to 100%)
 - E-rate (Federal) program - consultant
 - Technical
 - Procurement
 - Project Management

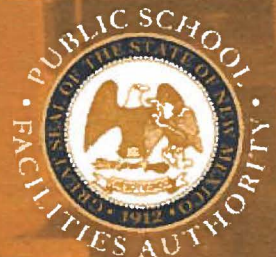

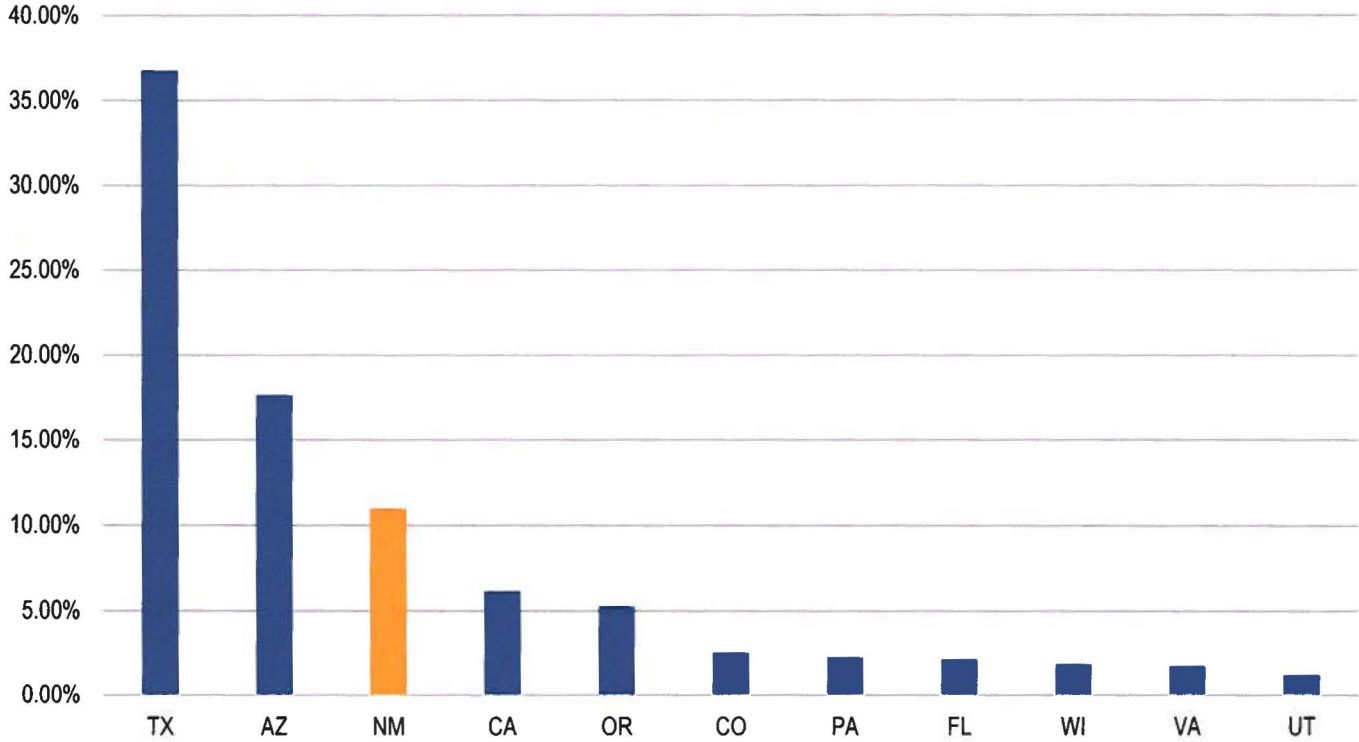
Public School Capital Outlay Funding: Broadband Deficiencies Correction Program

- 130 Projects funded ('16-'18): 80 / 50 closed out
- **\$60M Total work**
- **\$52.6M E-rate** / \$5.6M State (PSCOC) / \$1.8M Schools
- 2019: ~50 projects / ~\$22.5M
- 2020: Planning & Development

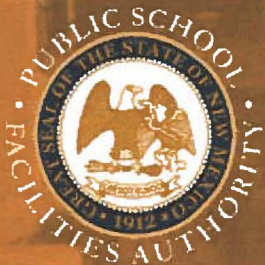

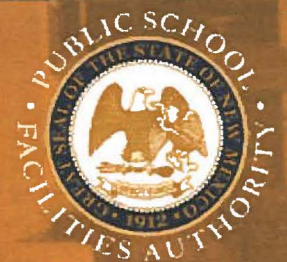
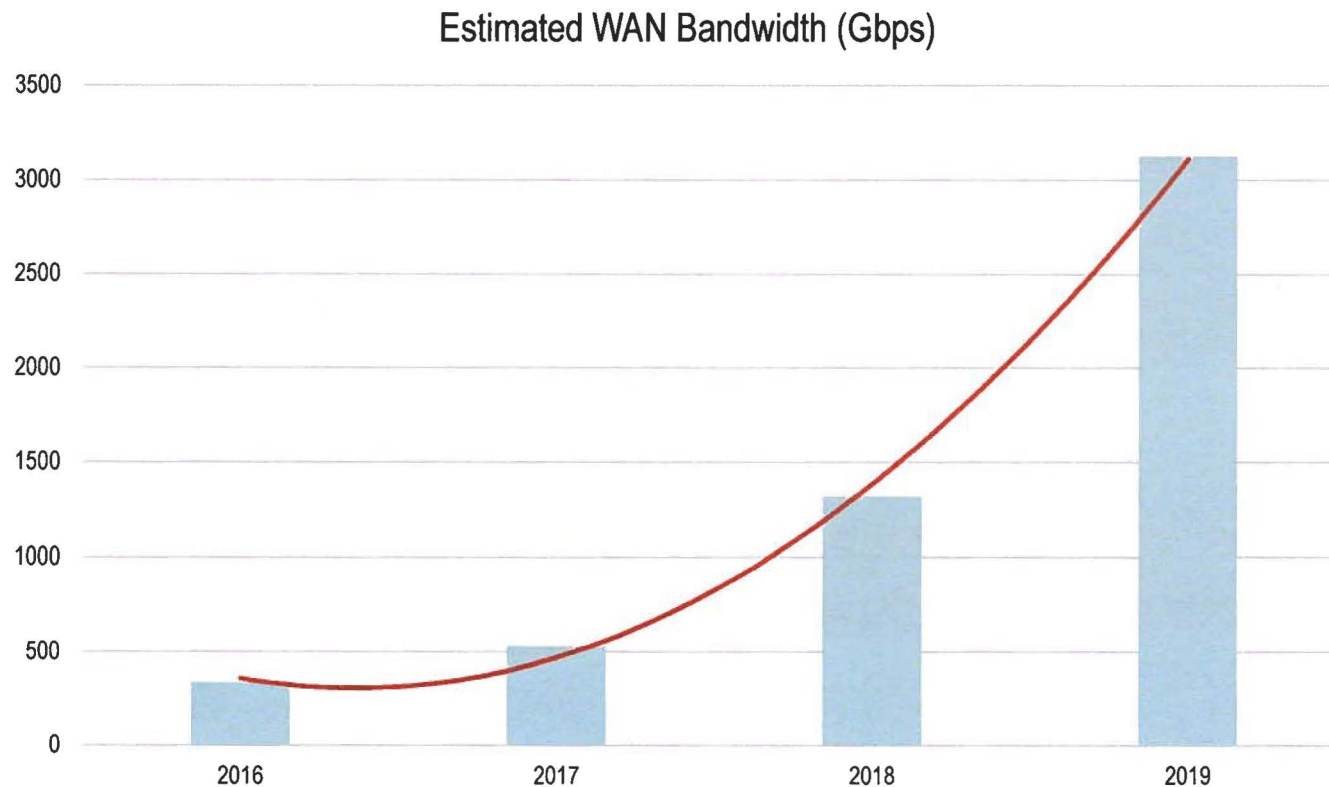
2016-2018 E-rate Fiber Funding (% of National)



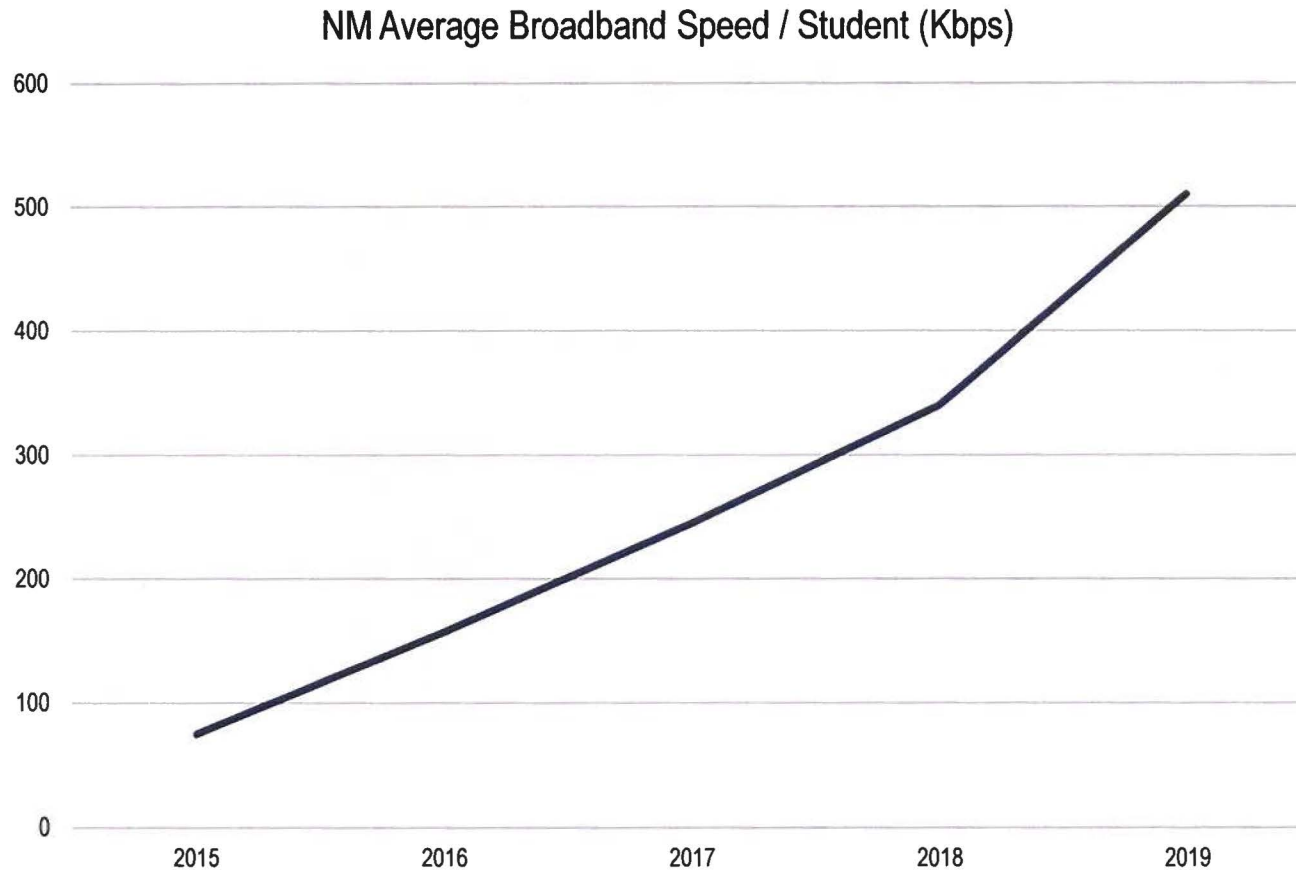
