- ▶ Population ≈ 110,000
- ▶ Area - 3814 mi<sup>2</sup>
- ▶ Density - 29 people/ mi<sup>2</sup>

## City of Las Cruces

- 110,000
- 76.6 mi<sup>2</sup>
- 1436 people/ mi<sup>2</sup>

|              | DAC     | CLC    |
|--------------|---------|--------|
| ► Total -    | 1328 mi | 485 mi |
| ► Paved -    | 563 mi  | 482 mi |
| ► Un-paved - | 765 mi  | 3 mi   |

# Property Ownership

|                   | DAC | CLC |
|-------------------|-----|-----|
| ► Federal -       | 75% | 14% |
| ► State -         | 9%  | 7%  |
| ► Private/Other - | 16% | 79% |

# Budget

|                        | DAC  | CLC  |

| ► Personnel -          | 59   | 118  |
| ► Budget (million \$)- | 21.8 | 83.9 |
| ► Grants (million \$)- | 15.2 | 5.3  |
