


































































Federal funding freezes are causing uncertainty, confusion and frustration at state agencies.

 Several grants were frozen and are still in limbo, especially USDA.


 Landowners in Socorro have experienced uncertainty with NRCS match grants, impacting NHCA applications.



The application process and time restraints are keeping New Mexicans from applying for grants.

 NMED River Stewardship: application is very challenging for SWCD staff, many of whom are unpaid.

 The two-year time limit for River Stewardship grants is keeping NGOs and subcontractors from applying.
