- 603.5 Vacant positions
 (20% unfunded vacancy rate)
- ✤ 157 Positions Posted
 - ✤ 105 in Protective Services
 - ✤ 17 in Program Support
 - ✤ 28 in Juvenile Justice Services
 - ✤ 7 in Behavioral Health Services

✤ 34 hires in last 30 days



CYFD Workforce



- In January 2023 Protective Services was at 29% vacancy rate June 2024, we have reduced the Protective Services vacancy rate to 21%
 - Pre-apprentice program with Department of Workforce Solutions
 - * Stipend Program
 - ***** 33 Stipend students past academic year
 - * 15 Stipend students August 2024
 - ✤ Loan Repayment
 - *** \$3** million reauthorized for recruitment efforts
 - ***** Participated in 62 career/job fairs during calendar year 2024
