- Program Enhancements (2022 2025)
 - Addition of a Practicum Instructor (FY24 and FY25)
 - Expansion and Support for our Professional Social Work Licensure Preparation Program Efforts
 - Recruitment Efforts
 - Meet and Greet/Drop In Hours
 - Lunch and Learn Events
 - Graduate, Transfer and High School Fairs (NM and Region)
- Training Component Expansion



ENDOWMENT FUND SPENDING

- \$16.5 M awarded through the NM True Faculty Endowment
- Invested with the NMSU Foundation with an expected yield of 4%,
- Two Endowed Faculty have been hired



- Funding used to support hiring of temporary faculty while searching for permanent endowed faculty
- An additional endowed faculty search is underway; October forecast may allow one more hire in spring



ENDOWMENT FUND SPENDING

\$1.8 million was awarded for graduate student paid practicums

Invested with NMSU Foundation March 2024, expected yield of 4%

The fund requires one year of maturity prior to disbursements

Initial disbursement planned for January of 2026

Funding will be available for practicums starting in fall 2026

Approx. 10 students will receive \$5000 for their practicum placement



PLANS FOR GROWTH

- Continue to hire for endowed positions
- •Expand marketing for new BSW and MSW programs through Global
- Double overall enrollment within next five years
- Provide paid internships through endowment, Title IV-E, Work-study and other funding mechanisms
- •Expand curriculum to include potential certificates in School Social Work, Mental Health, Chemical Dependency and work with immigrants and refugees
