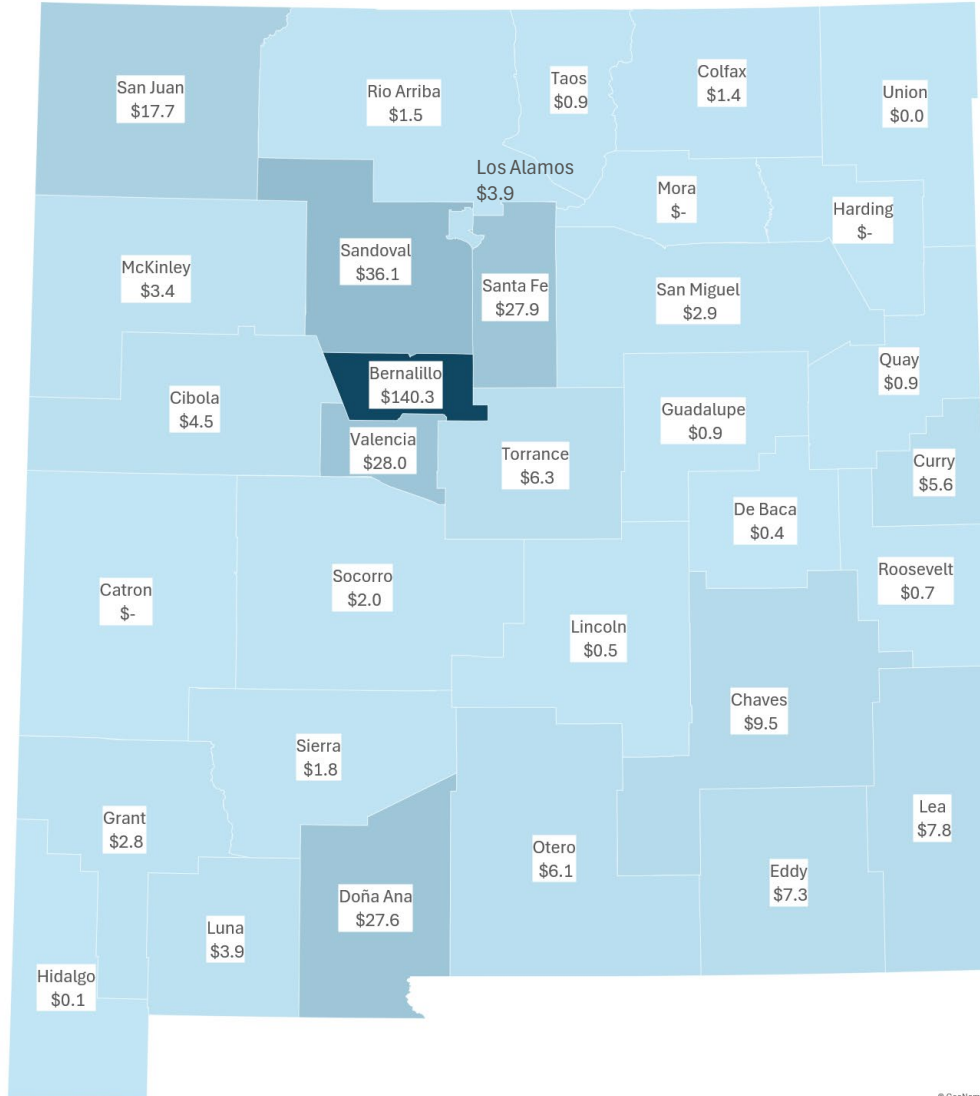
As of Q2-2026 Housing New Mexico provided \$352.47 million in funding for affordable housing, impacting 17,995 households.

This impact includes 2,274 homes produced, preserved, or financed. Rental and single-family development alone contributed to \$228.95 million in direct and indirect economic impact, and 2,811 jobs supported, from construction activity and induced effect of spending income and tax revenue.

Create More Housing	Provided \$32.19 million to produce 860 homes. • \$27.36 million to produce 790 multifamily homes. • \$4.83 million to produce 70 single family homes.
Preserve Existing Affordable Housing	Provided \$9.9 million to preserve 368 homes. • \$5.08 million to rehabilitate 135 homes. • \$4.82 to weatherize 233 homes.
Create Homeownership & Wealth Building Opportunities	Provided \$275.83 million in first mortgage and downpayment assistance to 1,046 families. • \$262.4 million in first mortgage financing to 1,046 families. • \$13.43 million in downpayment assistance totaling 1,595 loans.
Create Stable Housing Environments	Provided \$34.55 million for housing stability to 15,721 people and families. • \$29.72 million for on-going rental assistance for 5,943 families. • \$2.88 million for medium-term rental assistance and housing stability to 5,508 families. • \$1.53 million for homelessness services & shelter operations for 4,108 families. • \$420,000 in landlord incentives to rent to 162 families with housing vouchers.

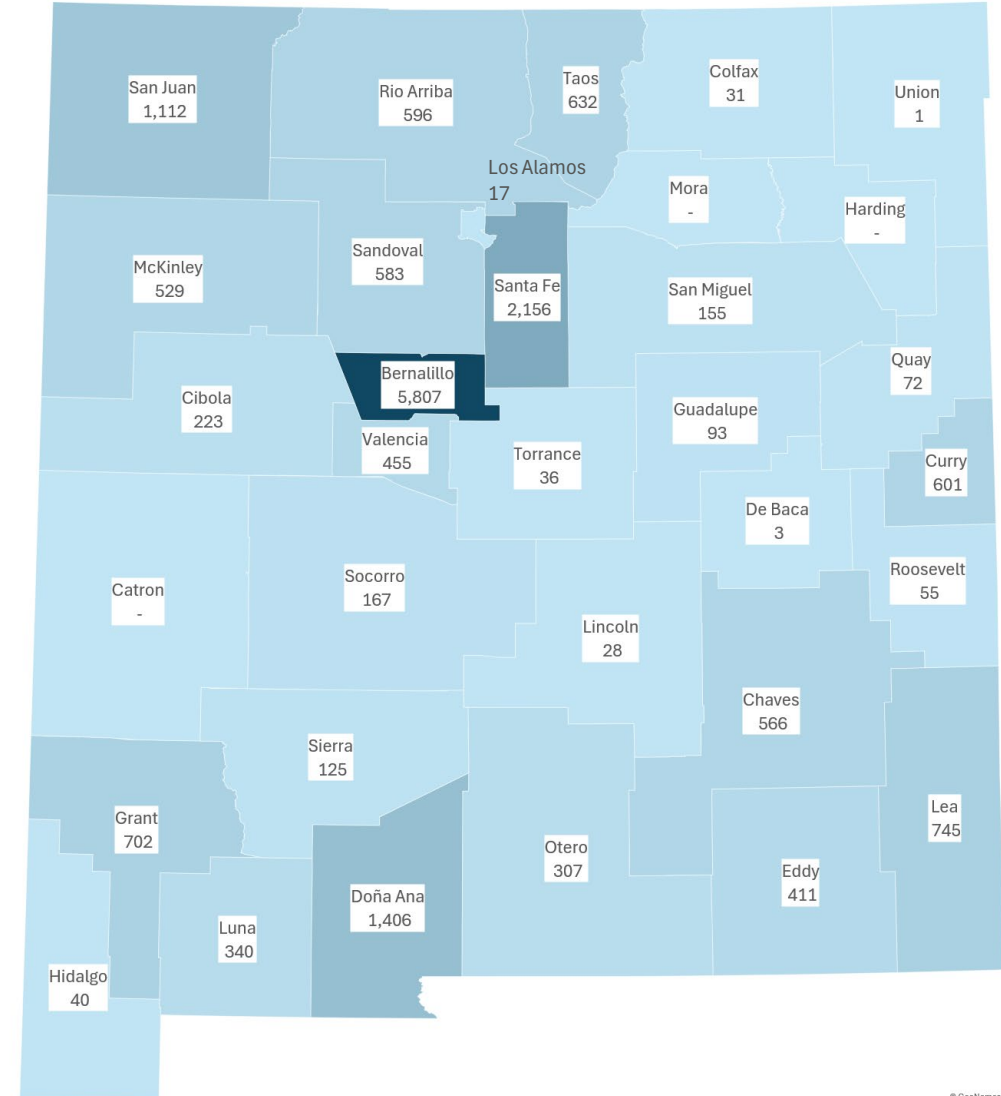
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Fiscal Year 2026 - Funding Provided by County (Millions)
